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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 24, TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES, BY REVISING SECTION 201, TITLED "ABATEMENT", OF CHAPTER 2, TITLED "PROCEDURE FOR ABATEMENT"; RELATED TO NUISANCE ABATEMENT EXTENSION FEES AS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION "F", REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 201. Subsection "F" only, in Section 201, Titled "Abatement", in Chapter 2, Titled "Procedure for Abatement", in Title 24, Titled "Nuisances" of Tulsa Revised Ordinances ("TRO") is hereby amended to recite in its entirety as follows:

- "F. An extension of fourteen (14) days in which to self-abate the nuisance may be applied for by paying the nuisance abatement extension fee as set forth in Section 122, in Chapter 1 of Title 49, TRO, per extension. To qualify for the extension, the applicant shall:
 - 1. Be eighteen (18) years of age or older;
 - 2. Not be in default on any debt to the City of Tulsa; and
 - 3. State the need for the extension of time for which a hardship prevents prompt compliance.

Instructions for receiving this enlargement of time to abate the nuisance shall be included in the original notice. The Enforcement Official shall not grant an extension if to do so poses imminent threat to life or property. No extension shall be granted without prior payment of the nuisance abatement extension fee. No more than two (2) extensions shall be granted, except where necessary concerning dilapidated structures as contemplated in Section 402 hereof."

- **Section 2. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES**. That all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are now expressly repealed.
- **Section 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason found to be invalid by a court of competent

jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or any part thereof.

Section 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. That the amendments hereby enacted are essential to the proper, orderly and ethical conduct of the business of the City of Tulsa by its City Officials; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
