AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA, BE AND IT IS HEREBY AMENDED TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND FIFTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$5,575.57) FROM UNASSIGNED FUND BALANCE WITHIN THE FIRE EQUITABLE SHARING PROGRAM SUBFUND (SUBFUND 2401), AS FOLLOWS:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. That the Fiscal Year 2022-23 Budget of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be and it is hereby amended to make supplemental appropriations of Five Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars and Fifty-Seven Cents (\$5,575.57) from unassigned fund balance within the Fire Equitable Sharing Program Subfund (Subfund 2401), as follows:
