ORDINANCE NO.	

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 27, TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES, TITLED "PENAL CODE", CHAPTER 3, TITLED "OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC JUSTICE"; ADDING A NEW SECTION 311, TITLED "UNLAWFUL BYPASS OF A SECURITY CHECKPOINT"; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF SECTION 311; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. That Title 27, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, Chapter 3, titled "Offenses Against Public Justice", be and the same is now amended by adding a new Section 311, titled "Unlawful bypass of a security checkpoint", to read as follows:

"Section 311. Unlawful bypass of a security checkpoint

Any building, facility, or outdoor area enclosed by a fence or other similar barrier requiring persons to pass through a security check point used to screen people and their belongings prior to entering and submit to inspection or screening shall post notice stating this requirement and, at a clearly identified checkpoint, informing them that persons and their belongings are subject to search prior to entry. All persons approaching a security checkpoint established in compliance with requirements of this paragraph shall, prior to entering, obey the instructions and orders of security staff conducting inspections and screenings and may otherwise be subject to the commission of the following offenses:

- A. It shall be unlawful and an offense for any person, without authorization, to willfully bypass or go around a security checkpoint when entering any building, facility, or enclosed outdoor area requiring persons to pass through a security checkpoint used for inspecting or screening persons or their belongings prior to entry.
- B. It shall be unlawful and an offense for any person, without authorization, to aid or assist any person or persons in bypassing a security checkpoint to any building, facility, or enclosed outdoor area requiring persons to pass through a security checkpoint used for inspecting or screening persons or their belongings prior to entry by opening, holding open, or propping open any otherwise secured door, entryway, window, or any other avenue of entry.
- C. It shall be unlawful and an offense for any person, without authorization, to aid or assist any person in bypassing or avoiding a security checkpoint requiring persons to pass through a security checkpoint used for inspecting or screening persons or their belongings prior to entry by passing uninspected or unscreened items or belongings, or receiving them, through an otherwise secured door, entryway, window, loading dock, or any other avenue of entry.

- **D.** Every person committing an offense prescribed in this section shall, upon conviction, be punished by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period of not exceeding six (6) months or by a fine of not more than one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200.00), excluding costs, fees and assessments, or both such fine and imprisonment."
- Section 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are now declared to be severable.
- Section 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. That an emergency is now declared to exist for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety by providing for the protection of buildings and facilities and the establishment of security checkpoints which, for these reasons, this ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its adoption, approval and publication.
