Policy Statement

Background Information

This Ordinance will appropriate \$500,000.00, recognized revenue received through a Department of Justice 2022 Expanding Access to Sexual Assault Forensic Examinations Grant Program (Munis grant #23210), awarded to the Tulsa Police Department within the National Institute of Justice Research, Evaluation, and Development Project Grants SubFund (Subfund 2426). The purpose of this program is to establish or expand sexual assault examination programming, including sexual assault nurse examiner programming and sexual assault forensic examiner programming, that focuses on improving the provision of sexual assault care using a community-based approach. The program furthers the funding agency's mission by increasing the quality and quantity of services available to victims of sexual assault. The funds will be used for salary for the Project Coordinator, Statewide Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) Coordinator, and Statewide Clinical Coordinator; pay nurses to mentor inexperienced nurses through a telehealth system; travel; and supplies.

There is no match required for this grant.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA, TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$500,000.00) FROM GRANT REVENUES TO BE RECEIVED FROM THE OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE WITHIN THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF JUSTICE RESEARCH, EVALUATION, AND DEVELOPMENT PROJECT GRANTS SUBFUND (SUBFUND 2426), AS FOLLOWS:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. That the Fiscal Year 2022-23 Budget of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be and it is hereby amended to make supplemental appropriations of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$500,000.00) from grant revenues to be received from The Oklahoma Department of Justice within the National Institute of Justice Research, Evaluation, and Development Project Grants Subfund (Subfund 2426)
