RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A NON-PARTISAN SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF TULSA. STATE OF OKLAHOMA, ON THE 8<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF AUGUST, 2023, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE REGISTERED, QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA THE OUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS OF SAID CITY IN THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY MILLION, FIFTY FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100S DOLLARS (\$170.055.000.00) TO BE ISSUED IN SERIES, TO PROVIDE FUNDS (EITHER WITH OR WITHOUT STATE OR FEDERAL AID) FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACOUIRING, CONSTRUCTING, RECONSTRUCTING, EXTENDING, ENLARGING, IMPROVING, AND REPAIRING STREETS BRIDGES AND TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS WITHIN THE CITY, AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 27, ARTICLE X OF THE OKLAHOMA CONSTITUTION, AND STATUTES OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA AND ACTS SUPPLEMENTARY AND ENACTED PURSUANT THERETO; AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE REGISTERED, QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS OF SAID CITY IN THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY SIX MILLION. SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100S DOLLARS (\$146,725,000.00) TO BE ISSUED IN SERIES, TO PROVIDE FUNDS (EITHER WITH OR WITHOUT STATE OR FEDERAL AID) FOR THE PURCHASING, CONSTRUCTING, EQUIPPING, PURPOSE OF IMPROVING. EXTENDING, RENOVATING, AND REPAIRING PUBLIC PARKS AND PARK LANDS, CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES, ALL TO BE OWNED EXCLUSIVELY BY SAID CITY, AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 27, ARTICLE X OF THE OKLAHOMA CONSTITUTION, AND STATUTES OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA AND ACTS SUPPLEMENTARY AND ENACTED PURSUANT THERETO; AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE REGISTERED, QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS OF SAID CITY IN THE SUM OF SIXTY EIGHT MILLION, ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND AND NO/100S DOLLARS (\$68,120,000.00) TO BE ISSUED IN SERIES, TO PROVIDE FUNDS (EITHER WITH OR WITHOUT STATE OR FEDERAL AID) FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECONSTRUCTING, IMPROVING, CONSTRUCTING, REPAIRING AND/OR PURCHASING PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES, ALL TO BE OWNED EXCLUSIVELY BY SAID CITY, AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 27, ARTICLE X OF THE OKLAHOMA CONSTITUTION, AND STATUTES OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA AND SUPPLEMENTARY AND ENACTED PURSUANT THERETO: AND IN ACTS CONNECTION WITH EACH OF SAID BONDS, THE QUESTION OF LEVYING AND COLLECTING AN ANNUAL TAX, IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER TAXES, UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN SAID CITY FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE INTEREST AND PRINCIPAL OF SAID BONDS: LISTING SPECIFIC PROJECTS PURSUANT TO TITLE 62 OKLAHOMA STATUTES, SECTION 574, WITH A FURTHER LISTING OF THE DOLLAR AMOUNTS TO BE EXPENDED ON EACH PROJECT; REQUESTING THE MAYOR TO ISSUE A PROCLAMATION AND NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION AS PROVIDED IN ARTICLE VI OF THE AMENDED CHARTER OF THE CITY OF TULSA, SECTION 4; REOUESTING THAT ABSENTEE BALLOTS BE PROVIDED FOR SAID ELECTION IN THE MANNER AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH PROVISIONS NOW ESTABLISHED BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA; NOTIFYING THE TULSA, OSAGE, ROGERS, AND WAGONER COUNTY ELECTION BOARDS OF THE HOLDING OF SUCH ELECTION: SETTING FORTH OTHER INFORMATION NECESSARY FOR CONDUCTING ELECTIONS: PROVIDING SAID FOR SEVERABILITY: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the City of Tulsa to acquire, construct, reconstruct, extend, enlarge, improve, and repair streets, bridges and transportation systems within said City; and to purchase, construct, equip, improve, extend, renovate, and repair public parks and park lands, cultural and recreational facilities; and to construct, reconstruct improve, repair and/or purchase public safety buildings and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the estimated amount necessary for the City to acquire, construct, reconstruct, extend, enlarge, improve, and repair streets, bridges and transportation systems within said City is the sum of One Hundred Seventy Million, Fifty Five Thousand and no/100s Dollars (\$170,055,000.00); and the amount necessary to purchase, construct, equip, improve, extend, renovate, and repair public parks and park lands, cultural and recreational facilities is the sum of One Hundred Forty Six Million, Seven Hundred Twenty Five Thousand and no/100s Dollars (\$146,725,000.00); and the amount necessary to construct, reconstruct improve, repair and/or purchase public safety buildings and facilities is the sum of Sixty Eight Million, One Hundred Twenty Thousand and no/100s Dollars (\$68,120,000.00);

WHEREAS, power is granted to said City by Section 27, Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, and other laws of the State of Oklahoma, to issue bonds to provide funds for such purposes, provided the same be authorized by the registered, qualified voters thereof voting at an election held for that purpose; and WHEREAS, the eighth (8<sup>th</sup>) day of August 2023 is a designated election day of the State of Oklahoma per Title 26 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 3-101, and is convenient for holding a special election in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, to authorize the issuance of the said bonds; and

WHEREAS, Title 26 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 13-102, requires the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, to give, sixty (60) days' notice of said special election to the Tulsa, Osage, Rogers, and Wagoner County Election Boards, stating therein the date of said election, the questions to be voted upon at said election, and other information necessary for conducting the said election; and

WHEREAS, Title 26 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 14-101, Sections 14-136 through 14-155, and Title 10 Tulsa Revised Ordinances, Section 100, provide for absentee ballots in all primary, general, or special elections conducted in the City of Tulsa in the manner and in accordance with the provisions now established by the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

### NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. That the Tulsa, Osage, Rogers, and Wagoner County Election Boards be and are hereby requested to conduct a non-partisan special election, and the Mayor of the City of Tulsa is hereby requested to issue a proclamation and notice calling a non-partisan special election, to be held in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2023, for the purpose of submitting to the registered qualified voters thereof the following propositions:

"BOND PROPOSITION NO. 1 (Streets, Bridges and Transportation Systems Bonds)

Shall the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of One Hundred Seventy Million, Fifty Five Thousand and no/100s Dollars (\$170,055,000.00) to be issued in series, to provide funds (either with or without state or federal aid) for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, extending, enlarging, improving, and repairing streets, bridges and transportation systems within said City; and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all taxable property in said City, sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds as it falls due, and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of principal of said bonds when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of ten percent (10%), per year, payable semiannually and to become due serially within twenty-five (25) years from their date?"

## "BOND PROPOSITION NO. 2 (Community Facilities Bonds)

Shall the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of One Hundred Forty Six Million, Seven Hundred Twenty Five Thousand and no/100s Dollars (\$146,725,000.00) to be issued in series, to provide funds (either with or without state or federal aid) for the purpose of purchasing, constructing, equipping, improving, extending, renovating, and repairing public parks and park lands, cultural and recreational facilities, all to be owned exclusively by said City; and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the interest on such bonds as it falls due and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of ten percent (10%), per year, payable semiannually and to become due serially within twenty-five (25) years from their date?"

## "BOND PROPOSITION NO. 3 (Public Safety Buildings and Facilities Bonds)

Shall the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of Sixty Eight Million One Hundred Twenty Thousand and no/100s Dollars (\$68,120,000.00) to be issued in series, to provide funds (either with or without state or federal aid) for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing improving, repairing and/or purchasing public safety buildings and facilities, all to be owned exclusively by said City; and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all taxable property in said City, sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds as it falls due, and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of principal of said bonds when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of ten percent (10%), per year, payable semiannually and to become due serially within twenty-five (25) years from their date?"

The ballot setting forth the above Propositions shall also contain in connection with each Proposition the following words and symbols:

Section 2. That pursuant to Title 62 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 574, a listing of specific projects for which at least seventy percent (70%) of the proceeds of the aforesaid bonds shall be expended and a listing of dollar amounts to be expended on said specific projects under the above Proposition be and the same is as follows:

Section 3. That only the registered, qualified voters of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, may vote upon the Propositions as above set forth; and each Proposition, as above set forth, must be approved by a majority of the voters voting on that Proposition at the said election.

Section 4 That the Tulsa, Osage, Rogers, and Wagoner County Election Boards be and are hereby notified that, except as provided in the amended Charter and ordinances of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, all City elections and recounts of votes shall be conducted in accordance with the laws of Oklahoma. The approval of all propositions shall require a vote of 50% plus one vote majority.

Section 5. That the call for said non-partisan special election shall be by proclamation signed by the Mayor, and attested by the City Clerk, setting forth the Propositions to be voted upon; a listing of specific projects, together with dollar amounts for which at least seventy percent (70%) of the proceeds of the bonds shall be expended on the bond proposition, pursuant to Title 62 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 574; the number and location of the polling places; the date of the election; the hours of opening and closing the polls; and the ballots for the registered, qualified voters shall set forth the Propositions above mentioned to be voted upon substantially as set out in Sections 2; and the returns of said election shall be made to and canvassed by the County Election Boards of Tulsa, Osage, Rogers, and Wagoner Counties, Oklahoma, which boards shall canvass the results as in the case of a regular election and certify the results thereof as required by law.

Section 6. That the Tulsa, Osage, Rogers, and Wagoner County Election Boards be and are hereby notified that absentee ballots shall be provided for in this election in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, in the manner and in accordance with the provisions now established by the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

Section 7. That all precincts in the City of Tulsa, including those precincts only partially contained therein, shall be open for the said election, as required by Title 26 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 13-103.

Section 8. *Severability Clause.* If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution or any part thereof is for any reason found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution or any part thereof.

Section 9. *Emergency Clause.* That an emergency is hereby declared to exist for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, by reason whereof this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, approval and publication.
