Policy Statement

Background Information

Purpose: AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO TRANSFER APPROPRIATIONS. Attached is an ordinance (4 of 4) that requires the approval of the Mayor and the City Council as part of the FY 2023-2024 budget adoption. All are processed annually as part of the budget adoption process. An ordinance authorizing the Mayor to transfer unexpended and unencumbered capital project or grant appropriations from one city department to a successor department, with certain exceptions.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER ANY UNEXPENDED AND UNENCUMBERED CAPITAL PROJECT OR GRANT APPROPRIATION (OR ANY PORTION THEREOF) FROM ONE CITY DEPARTMENT TO A SUCCESSOR DEPARTMENT WITHIN THE SAME CITY FUND IN THE EVENT OF A REORGANIZATION OF DEPARTMENT FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES, WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS; EXPIRING JULY 31, 2024; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority of Article II, Section 7.3 of the Charter of the City of Tulsa, and Title 11, O.S.Supp.2007, § 17-215, and subject to the limitations and restrictions contained herein, the Mayor of the City of Tulsa, as the chief executive officer, is hereby authorized to transfer any unexpended and unencumbered capital project or grant appropriation (or any portion thereof) from one City department to a successor department within the same City fund in the event of a reorganization of the functions and duties of City departments; PROVIDED, that no appropriation for debt service or other appropriation required by law or ordinance may be reduced below the minimums required; PROVIDED, that any new capital project or capital maintenance project added to any capital fund shall be approved by the Council.

Section 2. This ordinance and the authorization contained herein shall expire on July 31, 2024.

Section 3. That an emergency is hereby declared to exist for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its adoption and approval.
