Policy Statement

Background Information

This Ordinance will transfer \$38.58 unencumbered balance from General Fund Personal Services to the Department of Justice OVC FY 2022 Enhanced Collaborative Model Task Force to Combat Human Trafficking grant, awarded to the Tulsa Police Department within the Services for Trafficking Victims subfund (2427). This transfer is to increase the grant match as required by the grantor. This actions will also transfer unencumbered balances from Personal Services, Other Services and Capital within the project account groups to Personal Services for fringe benefits and Other Services within the project for a digital forensic program. The purpose of the project will allow the Oklahoma Coalition Against Trafficking (OCAT), with Tulsa Police as it's law enforcement partner, to battle the disturbing crimes of human trafficking more effectively in the Tulsa area. The primary activities will include rescuing and protecting victims from their abusers, providing greater services to victims, improving sharing and community outreach, enhancing prosecutorial success, creating greater victim centered and collaborative approaches to addressing human trafficking, protecting underserved communities, and enhancing data collection. The in-kind match will consist of task force officers working regular hours on the grant project. Federal CFDA 16.320; Munis Grant 23209.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA, TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF THIRTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND FIFTY-EIGHT CENTS (\$38.58), FROM A GRANT MATCH, TO BE RECEIVED FROM THE GENERAL FUND (FUND 100) WITHIN THE SERVICES FOR TRAFFICKING VICTIMS SUBFUND (SUBFUND 2427); AND TO UNENCUMBERED TRANSFER AND **UNEXPENDED** APPROPRIATION BALANCES OF THIRTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND FIFTY-EIGHT CENTS (\$38.58) BETWEEN DEPARTMENTS AND ACCOUNT GROUPS WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND (FUND 100); AND TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED AND UNEXPENDED APPROPRIATION BALANCES OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$15,535.50) BETWEEN ACCOUNT GROUPS WITHIN THE SERVICES FOR TRAFFICKING VICTIMS SUBFUND (SUBFUND 2427), AS FOLLOWS:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. That the Fiscal Year 2022-23 Budget of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be and it is hereby amended to make supplemental appropriations of Thirty-Eight Dollars and Fifty-Eight Cents (\$38.58), from a grant match, to be received from the General Fund (Fund 100) within the Services for Trafficking Victims Subfund (Subfund 2427); and to transfer unencumbered and unexpended appropriation balances Fifteen Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars and Fifty Cents (15,535.50) between account groups within the Services for Trafficking Victims Subfund (Subfund 2427), as follows:
