AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA, TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$175,000.00) FROM GRANT REVENUES RECEIVED FROM THE UNITED STATES TREASURY AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT SUBFUND (SUBFUND 3001), AS FOLLOWS:
