 - a. ES 2013-13 Daris Contractors, LLC Contract No. 134298 Change Order No. 1 \$127,429.50 Approve Paul Zachary. Submitted for approval is Change Order No. 1 to Contract No. 134298, between the Tulsa Metropolitan Utility Authority and Daris Contractors, LLC for Project No. ES 2013-13, in the amount of \$127,429.50. Change Order No. 1 is necessary to replace the existing lift station's control system to a modern control system in compliance with the recently adopted Tulsa WWTP standards and software guidelines. The Change Order will be for the Control Panel, complete with PLC System, Network Hardware, UPS SCADA Terminal, Redundant DC Power Supplies, Surge Suppressors for all inputs, Fiber Patch Panel, terminations, Commissioning, Testing, Startup, Training, Warranty Services, etc. Add an additional 180 Calendar Days to all for Lead time (120 days) and Install (60 days). **RECOMMEND APPROVAL** (Contract No. 134298) (Tracking No. UB119091)

- **a.** TMUA-W 22-04 Keithline Engineering Group, PLLC Contract No. 134914 \$272,000.00 Approve Paul Zachary. Submitted for approval is the Agreement for Engineering Services between the Tulsa Metropolitan Utility Authority and Keithline Engineering Group, PLLC for Project No. TMUA-W 22-04, in the amount of \$272,000.00. The Scope of this Project includes Phase 1 Preliminary Design, to include various studies in order to make recommendations for bridge and roadway alignment to replace the existing bridge over Spavinaw Creek, located at D4530 Road and E0425 Road. Phase 2 Final Design, preparation of final plans for the project with all specifications and related contract documents required for construction. Phase 3 General Services during Construction, to provide assistance in submittals, prework, site visits and final inspections. **RECOMMEND APPROVAL** (Contract No. 134914) (Tracking No. UB119333)
- **b.** ENG 2020-15 Contract No. 137036 Resolution No. 20169 Mutual Release of Property from Wastewater System Approve Paul Zachary. Submitted for approval is a Mutual Release of Property from the 1989 Wastewater System Lease Agreement and Operation and Maintenance Contract. The City of Tulsa entered into a contract with Pamela Mace to exchange real property (Contract No. 137036) located along Bird Creek in the vicinity of the Northside Wastewater Treatment Plant. This exchange is part of the City's plan to close and vacate a portion of North 105th Street East, which is adjacent to Northside Wastewater Treatment Plant. Title opinions prepared for this transaction identified a 1989 Wastewater System Lease Agreement and Operation and Maintenance Contract, which partially affects the City's property that is being transferred. In order to convey a clear title this Release is required. **RECOMMEND APPROVAL**
- c. AMENDMENT TO THE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN TMUA AND LAND LEGACY, INC. Approve Jeremy Ward. Submitted for approval is an Amendment to the Cooperative Agreement between the Tulsa Metropolitan Utility Authority ("TMUA") and Land Legacy, Inc. The amendment revises the TMUA contact from Roy Foster to Stefanie Hunter, updates the contact information for TMUA and Stefanie Hunter, and clarifies Provision 8.7 that all easements are to be assigned to the City of Tulsa. RECOMMEND APPROVAL
