 - TMUA-W 07-26 Crossland Heavy Contractors, Inc. Contract No. 136373 Change Order No. 2 - \$32,759.67 - Approve - Paul Zachary. Submitted for approval is Change Order No. 2 to Contract No. 136373, between the Tulsa Metropolitan Utility Authority and Crossland Heavy Contractors, Inc., for project No. TMUA-W 07-26 in the amount of \$32,759.67. The Change Order is necessary to increase the project cost and add an additional 7 Calendar Days to the contract to remove an existing lead joint discovered at S. Harvard Ave and E 32nd Place South and a change in scope from 24-inch x 6-inch tapping sleeve to a full 24-inch x 6-inch tee. **RECOMMEND APPROVAL** (Contract No. 136373) (Tracking No. UB119579)

b. ES 2018-01 – Daris Contractors, LLC – Contract No. 135439 Change Order No. 2 - \$94,130.99 – Approve – Paul Zachary. Submitted for approval is Change Order No. 2 to Contract No. 135439, between the Tulsa Metropolitan Utility Authority and Daris Contractors, LLC, for Project No. ES 2018-01, in the amount of \$94,130.99. The Change Order is necessary to increase the project cost and add 126 Calendar Days due to a change in scope to add air relief valves and related header piping to the Northside Lift Station inlet piping per attached documents. **RECOMMEND APPROVAL** (Contract No. 135439) (Tracking No. UB119563)

*5. MISC. ACTION ITEMS

- **a.** Special Lease: Lake Eucha Annual Gigging Tournament, The Green Country Giggers Association, \$500.00 Approve Eric Lee. Submitted for your consideration is a special lease agreement between the Tulsa Metropolitan Utility Authority, the City of Tulsa and the Green Country Giggers Association. The Green Country Giggers Association is hosting a gigging tournament at Lake Eucha and will be paying the City of Tulsa a non-exclusive rental fee of \$500.00 to utilize the boat ramps and campgrounds, obtain fishing permits and boat permits, and have authority to utilize the land around the lake from the second Saturday in April to the fourth Sunday in April. **RECOMMEND APPROVAL** (Contract No. 137737)
- **b.** Budget Amendment Sewer Capital Fund, Fund No. 7500, BA7500308, \$10,230,000.00 Approve Jake Epp. This action will appropriate a total of \$10,230,000.00 from Unappropriated Fund Balance to the Sewer Operating, Fund No. 750, and then transferred to Sewer Capital Fund, Fund No. 7500. The appropriation will be utilized for the following projects originally approved for FY22: Northside 13.2kV (Main) Switchgear (\$1,800,000.00), Crow Creek Rehab and Relief (\$6,000,000.00), and West Bank Lift Station Improvements (\$2,430,000.00). **RECOMMEND APPROVAL**
- c. Council Transfer Water Capital Fund, Fund No. 7400, CT7400310, \$17,100,000.00 Approve Jake Epp. This action will reappropriate \$17,100,000.00 from the Eucha Dam Anchoring project to Automatic Meter Reading (\$8,000,000.00), Water Mains Replacements (\$6,000,000.00), and A.B. Jewell Water Treatment Plant Site Improvements (\$506,000.00). The Eucha Dam Anchoring project is being delayed due to a potential grant opportunity, which could offset 65% of the project costs. The Automatic Meter Replacement and Service Line inventory project requires additional appropriations to be awarded and to begin changing out 165,000 meters to AMR/AMI technology, while simultaneously inventorying the service lines as mandated by the EPA. The Water Mains Replacement project needs additional appropriations to complete waterline replacement portion of street projects that are planned to advertise for construction prior to FY24. The A.B. Jewell WTP Site Improvements Project needs additional appropriations to cover the Engineer's Estimate for the Base Bid plus Add Alternates, which is needed to reduce safety hazards at the A.B. Jewell WTP. RECOMMEND APPROVAL
