ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING TITLE 27 TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES (TRO), CHAPTER 21 “PRIVATE PROPERTY” SECTION 2106, “TRESPASSING”, BY AMENDING A SCRIVENER’S ERROR ADOPTED IN ORDINANCE 25185 AMENDING THE POTENTIAL PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATION OF SAID SECTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. That Title 27, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, be and the same is hereby amended by amending Chapter 21, Section 2106.B.2, to read as follows:

“2. Any person, upon conviction for a second violation of this section, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), excluding costs, fees and assessments, or by confinement in the City jail for a period of not more than ten (10) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.”

Section 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or any part thereof.

Section 3. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are now expressly repealed.
