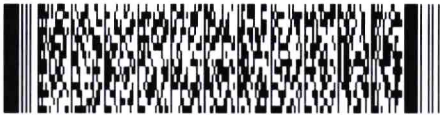

Policy Statement

Background Information

FY25 budget, MTTA is looking to increase fares to \$2.00 per trip (Fixed Route/Micro Transit) and \$4.00 a ride for Para Transit. Existing fares are \$1.75 per fixed route trip and \$3.50 for paratransit. Fares have not increased since July 2014. Inflation has risen at a rate of 2.93% per year between 2014 and 2024 for a total increase of 29.63%. The fare increase for both fixed route and paratransit is a 14% increase from current fares.

If approved, these new rates would go into effect on July 1st, 2024.

The RFA is being submitted by James Wagner as the Mayor's representative on the MTTA Board of Trustees.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE METROPOLITAN TULSA TRANSIT AUTHORITY TO INCREASE THEIR FARES ON THE FIXED ROUTE SYSTEM FROM \$1.75 TO \$2.00 PER TRIP AND THE PARATRANSIT SERVICE FROM \$3.50 TO \$4.00 PER TRIP, EFFECTIVE JULY 1st, 2024.

WHEREAS, the City of Tulsa created the Metropolitan Tulsa Transit Authority (MTTA) pursuant to a trust indenture dated August 2, 1968, and amended February 27, 1990, all as codified in Title 39 Tulsa Revised Ordinances, Chapter 9; and

WHEREAS, effective January 18, 1982, the City approved an operating license agreement with MTTA, recorded as Tulsa City Clerk Contract No. 9497, that requires City approval of rates and charges for services provided by MTTA, including free fares; and

WHEREAS the MTTA assists the community with transportation services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. MTTA is permitted to raise the fares for both services.

Section 2. Through appropriate action of its Board of Trustees, MTTA is empowered to regulate all aspects of the program including, but not limited to, modulating free fares by service type, day of week, time of day, early or limited termination, and other considerations it deems prudent.

Section 3. MTTA will monitor and evaluate the fare program. The City may request MTTA report the results.
