The Harbor - Volunteers for Youth Justice, Kelli Todd

The Harbor is a collaboration between the Volunteers for Youth Justice, Caddo Parish Public Schools, the Caddo Parish Commission, the Caddo Parish District Attorney's Office, and the City of Shreveport to meet the needs of children and families in the community. The Harbor is a one-stop shop for families to find multiple resources and services all under one roof. Children and their families have access to wrap-around services, mental health services, OT and PT therapy, parenting, workforce development, academic support, and truancy prevention.

The Early Childhood Education Initiative - Community Foundation of North Louisiana (CFNLA), Kristina Gustavson (to be held via Zoom at the Hilton)

Community Counts data from 2012 to the present reveals an alarming decrease in Kindergarten Readiness scores for Shreveport-Bossier. Currently, 60% of students who enter Caddo Schools score below the benchmark for K Readiness. Numerous studies indicate a lack of K Readiness correlates strongly with academic and behavioral challenges and involvement with juvenile and adult criminal justice systems. In the Fall of 2022, the City of Shreveport approved one-time funding of \$2.8 million for ECE Scholarships which resulted in \$2.8 million in matching state dollars. In 2024, CFNLA raised \$1.34 million which, when combined with an additional \$660,000 from the City, will result in a \$2 million state match, or a total of \$4 million.

Choice Neighborhood-Bayou Grande/Millennium Studios Public-Private Partnerships

In 2018, HUD awarded Shreveport a \$24.2 million Choice Neighborhoods Implementation Grant to leverage for the implementation of the housing, people, and neighborhood strategies identified in the City's communitydriven Transformation Plan. This made Shreveport one of just forty cities in the nation to be awarded a Choice Neighborhood grant. The project required a \$24 million match, which was exceeded; it ultimately raised \$140 million in additional investments. This revitalization of Millennium Studios is expected to have a cascading effect on job creation, attracting talent to the area and contributing to the overall economic resurgence of Shreveport.
