- Rezoning Application Z-7815 from RS-3 with an Optional Development Plan to RS-5 with an Optional Development Plan for property located north and west of the NW/c of E. 11th St. S. and S. 193rd E. Ave. requested by Tanner Consulting. (Property owners: Hensley Development Group, LLC) (CD-6) (TMAPC voted 9-1-0 to recommend APPROVAL of RS-5 zoning with an Optional Development Plan) [UED 6/18/25; CC 6/25/25; CC 7/16/25] 25-487-1 Supporting Documentation
- 3. Ordinance ZCA-35 amending the City of Tulsa Zoning Code, Title 42, Tulsa Revised Ordinances includes amendments to the City of Tulsa Zoning Code, Chapter 20 Overlay Districts, to add new Section 20.110, NCO-2, Neighborhood Character Overlay 2. The Board of the Florence Park Neighborhood Association formally voted to request the initiation of an NCO for their neighborhood. In addition to addressing scale and ADUs like the Renaissance NCO, the association requested additional regulations to prescribe roof pitches and building orientations. Florence Park Neighborhood can be generally described as the residentially zoned property within the area surrounded by E. 15th St. S.; E. 21st St. S.; S. Harvard Ave.; and the Broken Arrow Expressway. The first step in adopting the overlay is to amend the City of Tulsa Zoning Code to establish the regulations of an NCO specific to Florence Park, then adopt a zoning map amendment to apply the NCO to the Florence Park Neighborhood. Ordinance adopting the annual Assessment Roll for Tourism Improvement District No. 1; assessing those parcels of real property within city limits on which there is located a hotel or motel that has 110 or more rooms for the purpose of providing marketing services as set forth in 11 O.S. Section 39-103.1(A); providing the time and method for payment of said assessments and the penalty for non-payment. - Ordinance amending Title 55, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, titled "Property Maintenance Code," Chapter 3, titled "Structure and Premises Standards," Section 302, titled "Exterior Property Areas," by adding new sections 302.9 and 302.10 requiring that mailboxes be properly marked and maintained. - 6. Ordinance amending Title 24, Chapter 1, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, Section 103, titled "Nuisances Affecting Peace and Safety," declaring that commercial driveways, privately maintained streets, service roads, access roads, and similar areas, which are open to the public, and which present a driving hazard, endanger the safety of the public, or are otherwise constructed or maintained in violation of any ordinance shall be considered a nuisance affecting public peace and safety.
