

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-25 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA, IS HEREBY AMENDED TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF ONE HUNDRED AND NINETY NINE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$199,750.00) FROM GRANT REVENUES RECEIVED FROM THE PASS THROUGH ENTITY OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY STATE AND LOCAL CYBERSECURITY SUBFUND (SUBFUND 2602), AS FOLLOWS:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. That the fiscal year 2024-25 budget of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to make supplemental appropriations of one hundred and ninety nine thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars and zero cents (\$199,750.00) from grant revenues received from the pass through entity Oklahoma Department of Homeland Security State and Local Cybersecurity Subfund (Subfund 2602), as follows:
