RESOLUTION _____

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF TULSA MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN – 2024 UPDATE, CITED HEREIN IN DIGITAL FORMAT AND MADE A PART HEREOF; PROVIDING THAT COPIES OF SAID PLAN BE FILED AND KEPT IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK; MAKING SAID PLAN AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC AT A REASONABLE CHARGE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Tulsa and the surrounding area are subject to danger and damage from flooding, tornados, high winds, hail, lightning, excessive heat, drought, expansive soils, winter storms, and other natural and man-made hazards.

WHEREAS, the City of Tulsa prepared, adopted, and is implementing a Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan approved by the State of Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management (OEM) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) following State and Federal laws and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the 2000 Stafford Act mandates that communities must have an adopted and approved hazard mitigation plan before the community can apply for funds from the Pre-Disaster or Post-Disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, Flood Mitigation Assistance Program, Severe Repetitive Loss Program, and the Repetitive Flood Claims Program; and

WHEREAS, FEMA requires the plan to be fully reassessed and updated by the City every five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the City to update the Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan to further improve the safety and well-being of its citizens and the community by recommending activities and measures to reduce deaths, injuries, property damages, environmental and other losses from natural and manmade hazards.

WHEREAS, the Tulsa City Council designated the Stormwater Drainage and Hazard Mitigation Advisory Board (SDHMAB) to act as the Tulsa Hazard Mitigation Citizens Advisory Committee.

WHEREAS, the public had the opportunity to participate in the plan update and review the final drafted City of Tulsa Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan 2024 on July 25, 2023, December 18, 2023, and September 26, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. The City of Tulsa Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan 2024 Update, as presented to the City Council, together with all graphic representations referenced in the plan and any revisions required by the OEM or FEMA, is hereby approved as the City of Tulsa hazard mitigation plan as required by 44CFR Chapter 1, Subchapter D, Part 201.

Section 3. Copies of the City of Tulsa Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan 2024 Update will be made available to the public at a reasonable charge.

Section 4. The City of Tulsa Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan 2024 Update will be evaluated for effectiveness, accuracy, and possible modifications for improvement each year.

Section 5. An emergency exists to protect public health, safety, and welfare from natural and man-made disasters, and this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, approval, and publication.
