ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11-C, TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES, TITLED "WATERWORKS AND SEWERAGE"; AMENDING CHAPTER 7, TITLED "SANITARY SEWER USER CHARGE SYSTEM"; AMENDING SECTION 708 TO ADJUST SEWER SERVICE CHARGE RATES; PROVIDING THAT THESE RATES SHALL BE EFFECTIVE ON NOVEMBER 1, 2024; ESTABLISHING WHEN THE AMENDMENTS ENACTED BY THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME OPERATIVE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. That Title 11-C, Chapter 7, Section 708 Tulsa Revised Ordinances, be and the same is hereby amended to read and become operative on November 1, 2024 as follows:

"Section 708. Rate for dumping septic waste.

- A. The rate for dumping or discharging septic waste, Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., originating from inside or outside the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa shall be One Hundred Forty-Seven and 35/100 Dollars (\$147.35) for each one thousand (1,000) gallons and each overage or fraction less than one thousand (1,000) gallons. The rate for dumping or discharging septic waste at all other times shall be Two Hundred Six and 34/100 Dollars (\$206.34) for each one thousand (1,000) gallons and each overage or fraction less than one thousand (1,000) gallons.
- B. Septic waste shall be discharged only at facilities designated and approved by the Utility Board and the Mayor. No septic waste shall be discharged in the sanitary sewer system of the City except as provided in this title."

Section 2. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are now expressly repealed.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 4. *EMERGENCY CLAUSE. That an emergency is now declared to exist for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its adoption, approval and publication.*
