Background Information

This Ordinance will appropriate \$90,407.00, recognized revenue received through a District Attorney's Council 2023 Project Safe Neighborhoods-Operation Laser Focus (Munis grant #24218), awarded to the Tulsa Police Department within the Project Safe Neighborhoods SubFund (Fund No 2421). The purpose of this program is to create and foster safer neighborhoods through a sustained reduction in violent crime, including addressing criminal gangs and the felonious possession and use of firearms. This program provides critical funding, resources, and training for law enforcement, prosecutors, and their PSN teams to combat violent crime and make their communities safer through a comprehensive approach to public safety. The Tulsa Police Department will use overtime funds to reduce gang and violent gun crime through an increased focus on high quality and thorough investigations of gun crime, targeted patrol, and increased community engagement. There is no match required for this grant. CFDA #16.609.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-25 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA, TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF NINETY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVEN DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$90,407.00) FROM GRANT REVENUES TO BE RECEIVED FROM THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S COUNCIL WITHIN THE PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS SUBFUND (SUBFUND 2421), AS FOLLOWS:
