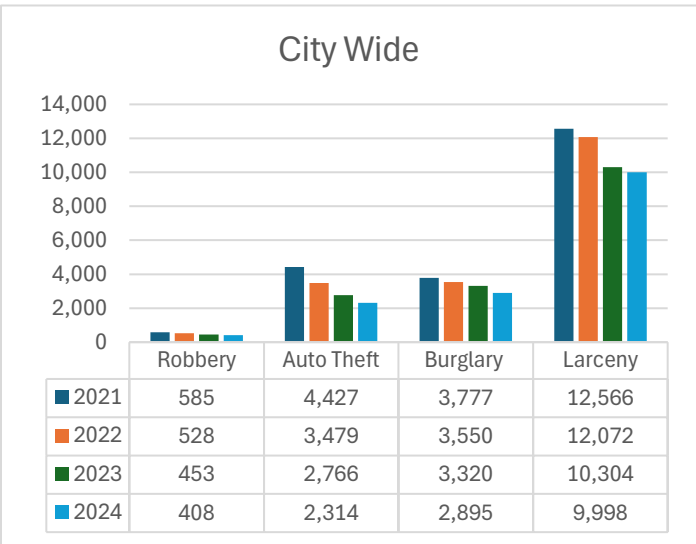




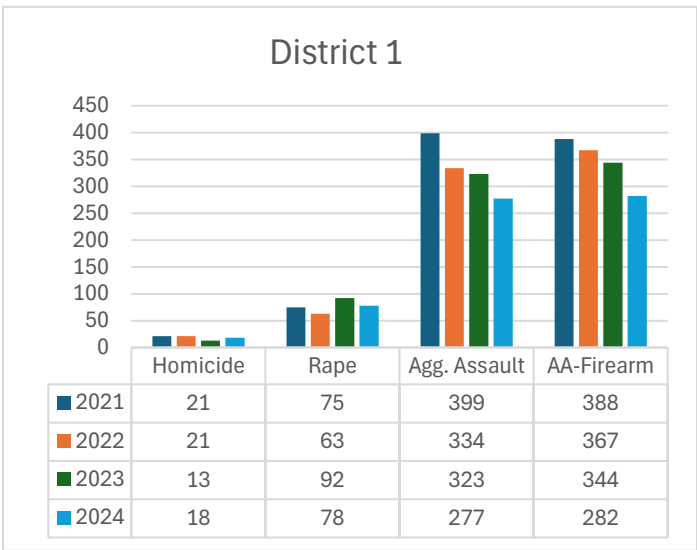
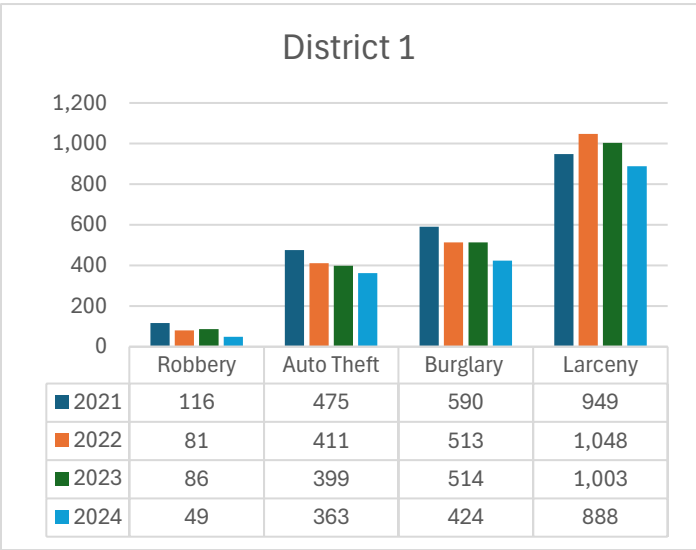
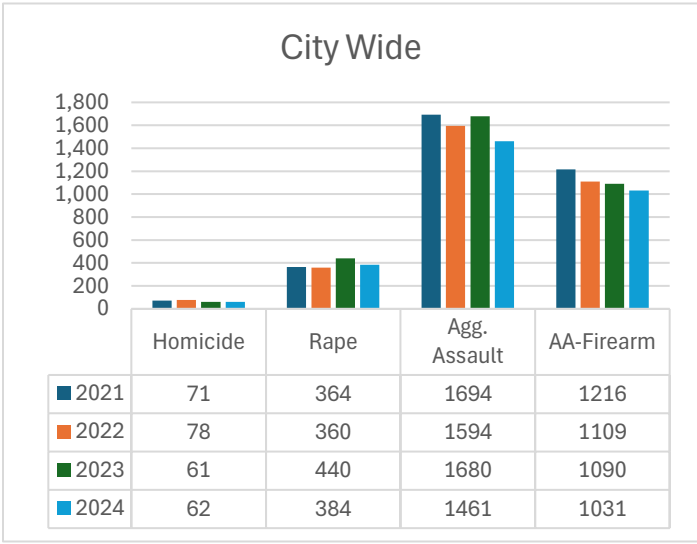
Four Year Comparison

- City Wide all reported incidents of crimes against property are decreasing each year.
- City Wide aggravated assault-firearm incidents are decreasing each year.
- District 1’s aggravated assault and aggravated assault-firearm incidents are both decreasing each year.
- In all but two districts, District 3 & District 5, 2024 had the lowest reported number of larceny incidents. For District 3 & District 5, 2023 had the lowest recorded number of larceny incidents.
- District 8, in 2024, had a record high number of reported aggravated assault-firearm incidents when compared to previous years.

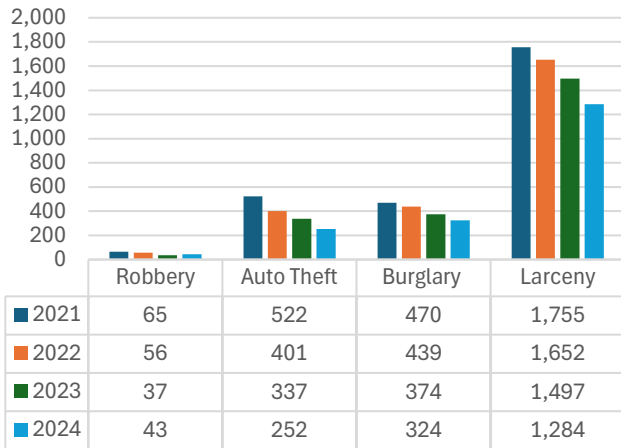

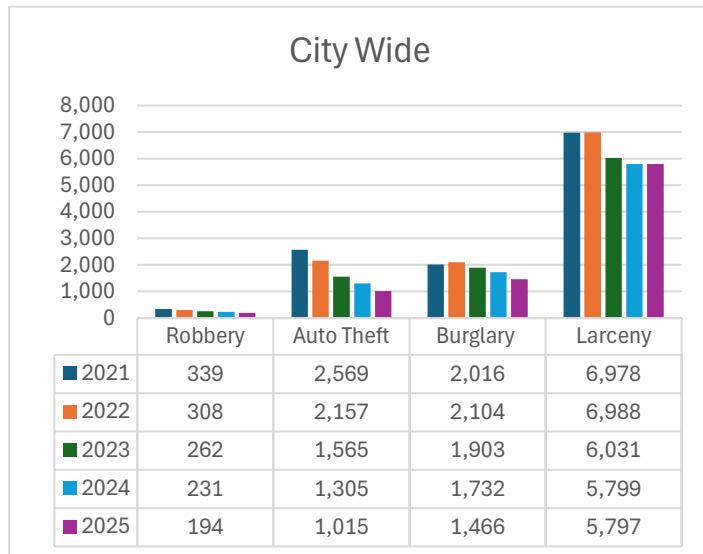


Year-to-Date Comparison

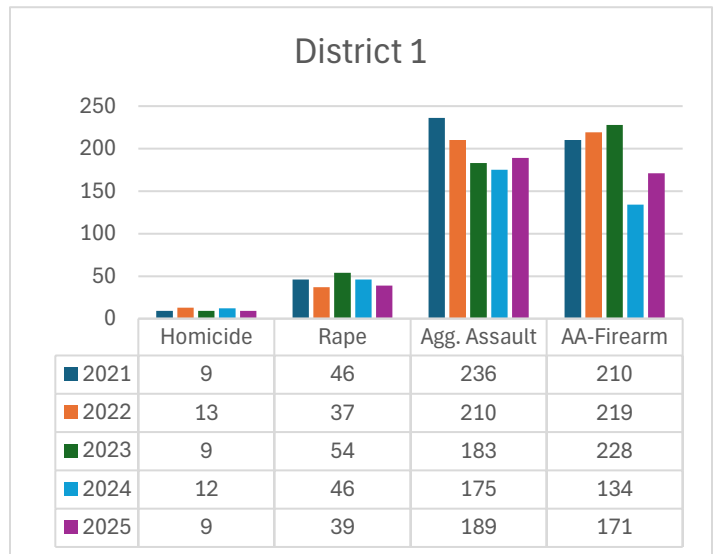
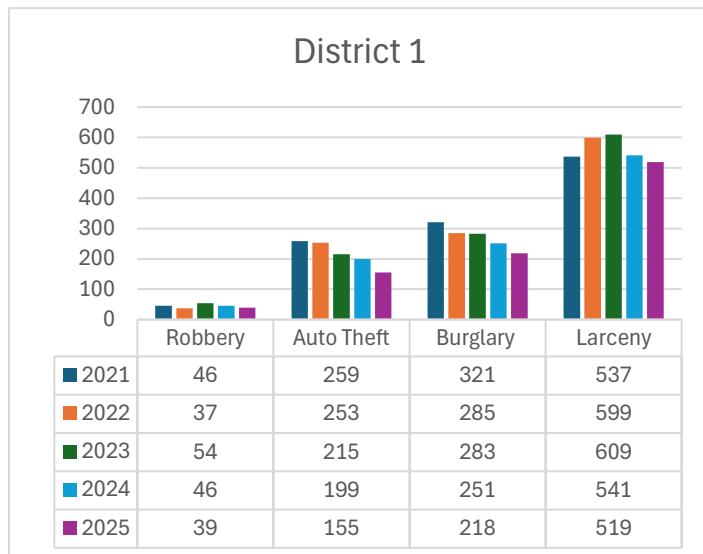
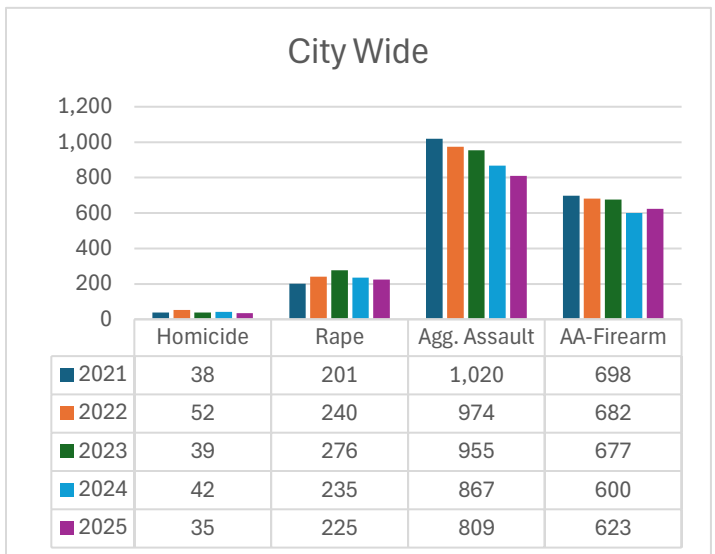
- The following bar graphs contains data from January 1 to July 31 of the corresponding year.
- City Wide the year of 2025 is showing fewer reported incidents against property, homicide, and aggravated assault by the end of July than years previous.
- In all locations, except District 6, there is a steady decline in the number of auto thefts being reported by the end of July each year.
- In District 6, 2025 has a record high number of homicides reported year to date when compared to previous years. There are six reported homicides in District 6 by July 31, 2025, where previously that number had been around two or three.
- In District 2 and District 7, 2025 has a record low number of homicides reported year to date when compared to previous years. In both District 2 & District 7 there are no reported homicides by July 31, 2025, where previously there had been at least two reported.
- In District 3, rape is seeing a higher-than-average number of reported incidents by July 31, 2025. Previously District 3 was averaging at about 30 reported rape incidents each year and 2025 has 37 reported rape incidents.

- In District 4 aggravated assault-firearm is seeing a higher-than-average number of reported incidents by July 31, 2025. Previously District 4 was averaging at about 54 reported aggravated assault-firearm incidents each year and 2025 has 62 reported incidents.

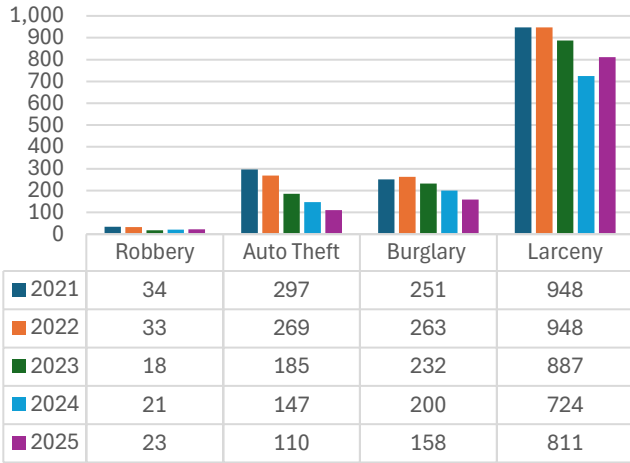

- Incidents may be uploaded into TRACIS after the release of this report.
- Incident data may not be quality-controlled and may be incomplete.
- Crime data is coded in accordance with the Federal Bureau of Investigations Uniform Crime Reporting Summary Program standards and not the National Incident-Based Reporting System.
- Incident data by Council Districts were obtained through ArcGIS Pro by geocoding citywide SSRS incident data at 97.98%.
- Incident data were analyzed in ArcGIS Pro and Microsoft Excel.
