Background Information

This ordinance will appropriate a total of \$90,253.00, recognized revenue received through a District Attorney's Council 2021 PSN Grant-Operation Trident (Munis grant #22226), awarded to the Tulsa Police Department within the Project Safe Neighborhoods subfund (Fund No. 2421). The purpose of the Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) program is to create and foster safer neighborhoods through a sustained reduction in violent crime. The effectiveness of this program depends upon the ongoing coordination, cooperation, and partnerships of local, state, tribal, and federal law enforcement agencies and the communities they serve, engaged in a unified approach led by the U.S. Attorney in all 94 federal judicial districts. The Tulsa Police Department will use overtime funds to reduce gang and violent gun crime through an increased focus on high quality and thorough investigations of gun crime, targeted patrol, and increased community engagement. There is no cash match required. Federal CFDA 16.609.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-22 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA, BE AND IT IS HEREBY AMENDED TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF NINETY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$90,253.00) FROM GRANT REVENUE AWARDED BY THE DISTRICT ATTORNEYS COUNCIL TO BE RECEIVED WITHIN THE PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS SUBFUND (SUBFUND NO. 2421) AS FOLLOWS:
