AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 14 TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES (“TRO”), “FIRE PREVENTION CODE”; ADDING A NEW SECTION, SECTION 105.6.49, “DECORATIVE HYDRANT PERMIT”, ALLOWING A PERMIT FOR THE PAINTING OR DECORATING OF A FIRE HYDRANT; AMENDING SECTION 507.5.1.3, “FIRE HYDRANT COLOR” BY THE ADDITION OF AN EXCEPTION TO THE RULE; ADDING A NEW SECTION, NAMELY, SECTION 507.5.1.4, “DECORATING OR PAINTING OF FIRE HYDRANTS WITHOUT A PERMIT”, FORBIDDING THE ALTERATION OF A FIRE HYDRANT WITHOUT A PERMIT; PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE PAINTING AND DECORATING OF CITY FIRE HYDRANTS; SETTING FORTH A REPEALER OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

*Section 1. That Title 14, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, “Fire Prevention Code” be amended by the addition of a new section, Section 105.6.49, to read as follows:*

**“Section 105.6.49-Decorative Hydrant Permit.** An operational permit is required to alter the color, decorate, or otherwise modify the appearance or view of a fire hydrant. Decorative hydrant permits are limited to specifically approved hydrants within areas approved by the Tulsa City Council. Within a Destination District, all hydrants will be of the same decorative specification. Multiple hydrants in a Destination District may be approved under one permit.”

*Section 2. That Title 14, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, “Fire Prevention Code” be amended by the amending Section 507.5.1.3, to read as follows*

**“Section 507.5.1.3-Fire Hydrant Color.** All fire hydrants on the public water distribution system shall be federal yellow in color. All other fire hydrants shall be red in color. Exception: Hydrants on the public water distribution system with an approved Decorative Hydrant Permit per Title 14 Section 105.6.49 and Title 13 Section 202.1.”

*Section 3. That Title 14, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, “Fire Prevention Code” be amended by the addition of a new section, Section 507.5.1.4, to read as follows:*

**“Section 507.5.1.4-Decorating or Painting of Fire Hydrants Without a Permit.** It shall constitute a violation of this code for any person, firm, corporation, or limited liability company

to alter the color, decorate, or otherwise modify the appearance or view of a fire hydrant without an approved Decorative Hydrant Permit in accordance with 105.6.49 and Title 13 Section 202.1.”

*Section 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or any part thereof.*

*Section 4. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are now expressly repealed.*

*Section 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. That the amendments hereby enacted are essential to the proper, orderly and ethical conduct of the business of the City of Tulsa by its City Officials; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication.*
