3M: On River Parks Trail, 59 m S of the NatureWorks Elk Statue. (GPS 36.0720 -95.9821)

4M: On RP Trail, 24 m N of the trail split S of the I-44. (36.0861 -95.9849)

5M: 30 meters N of Riverside & E 43rd Place intersection. (36.1005 -95.9845)

6M: On the south side of the gathering place, At the center of the public bike racks N of the Basketball courts (GPS 36.1147 -95.9849)

Turn: In the Gathering Place, 6.5 m N of the N edge of the side walk going to the swings. Also .5 m N of the 3rd Cross walk warning stripe. (36.1222 -95.9862)






Turn Detail Map




Start/Finish Detail Map



Pass out water and cheer for runners. Half marathon runners will run past you and then start passing you again around 90 minutes later, roughly.

5K runners will turn around at this point. Encourage them and let them know they are half way done.

When half marathoners are returning, celebrate them BIG. This is the hardest part where they are going to want to quit. Start expecting them at around 9:25 or 9:30am.

When they see you on their way back, they will have completed over 11 miles.


