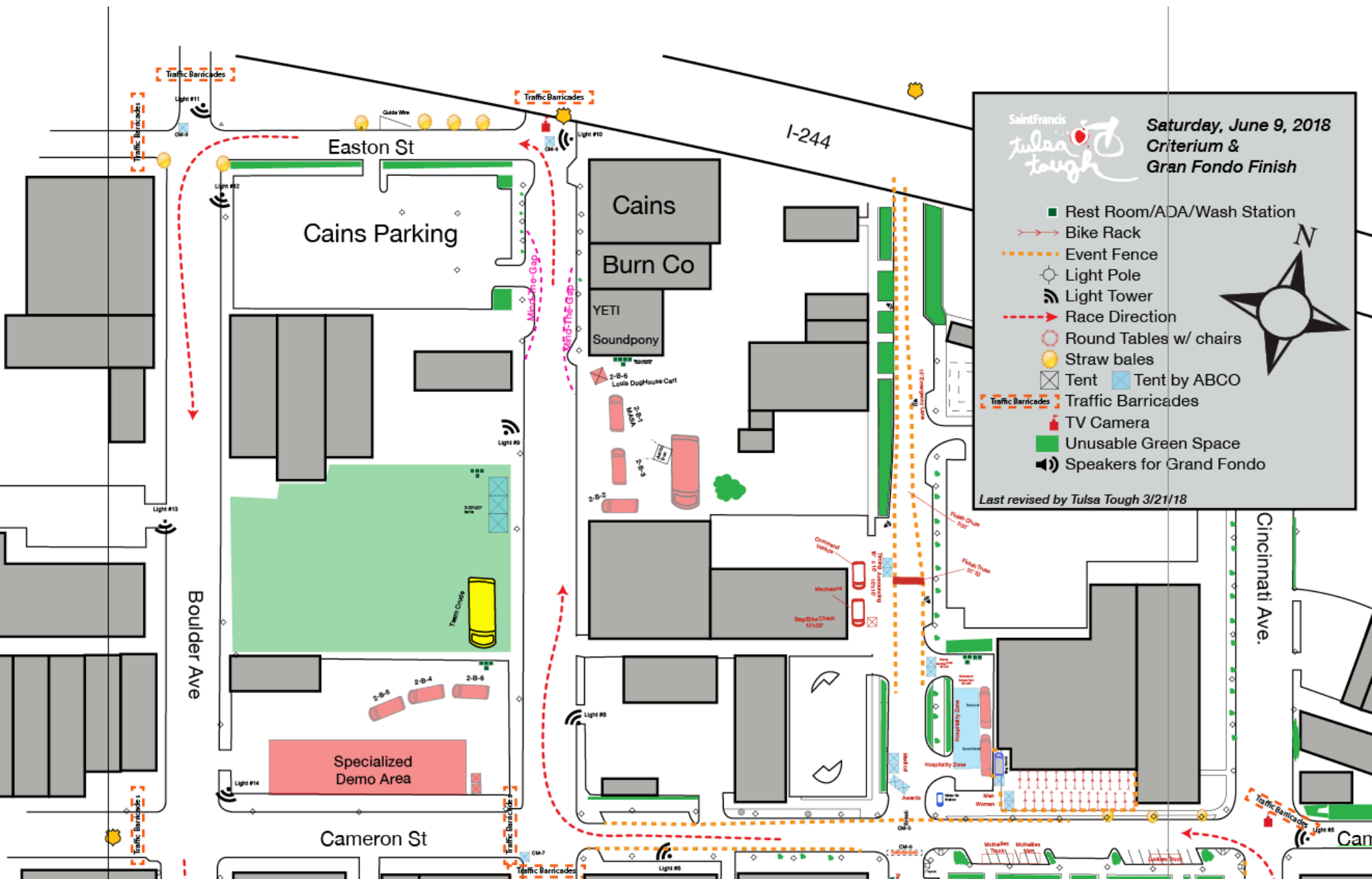

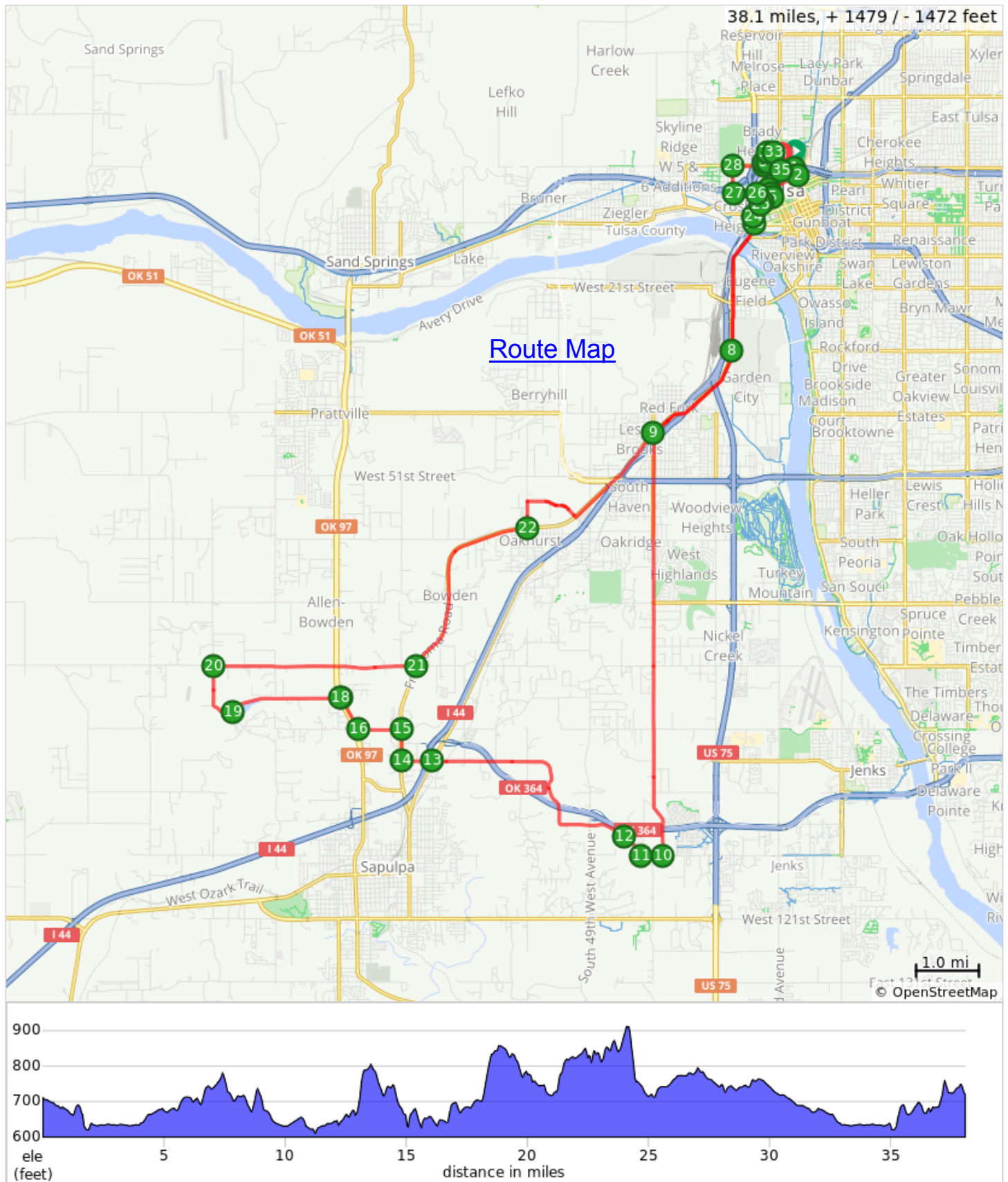

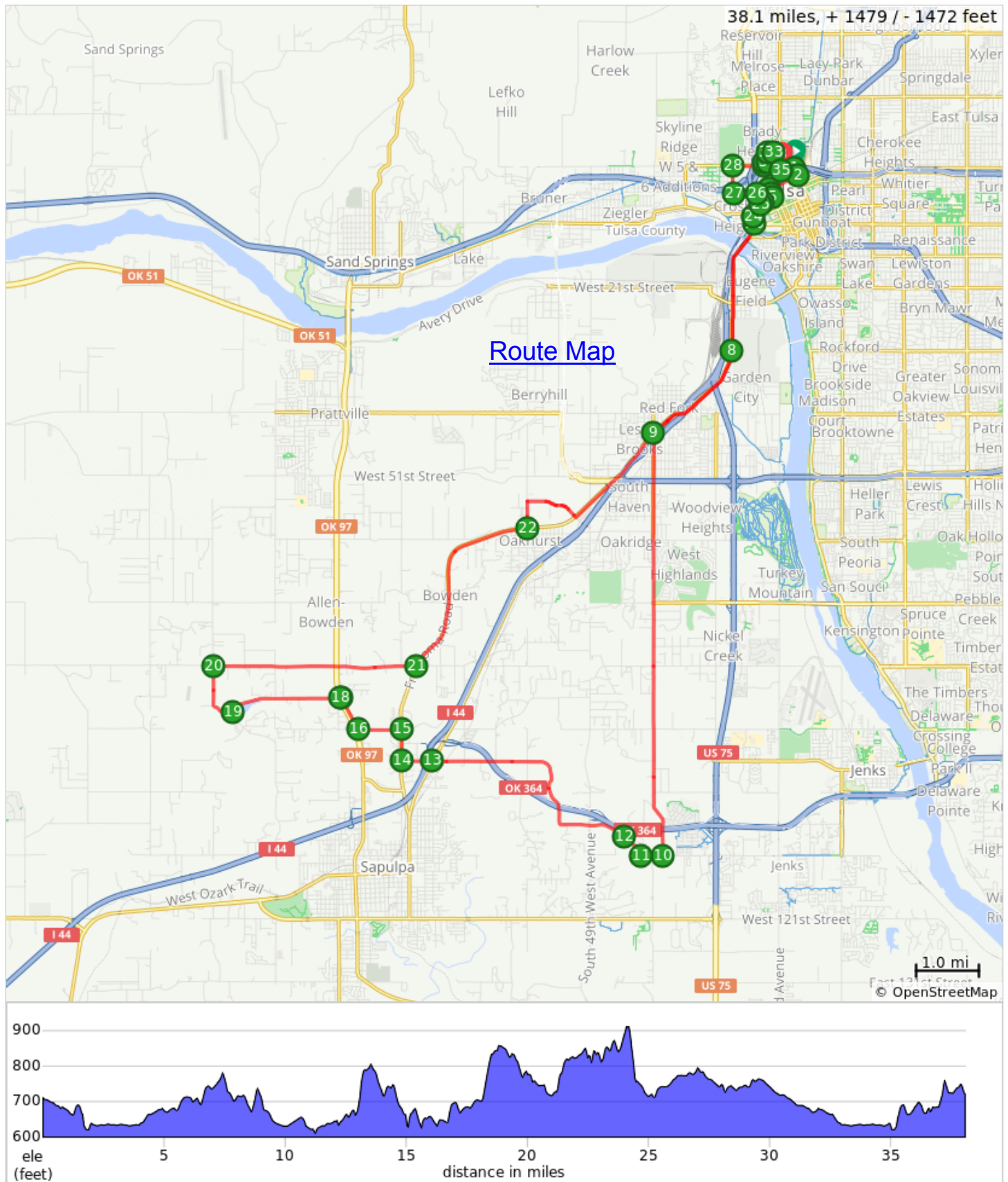
2019 SFTT Sat Piccolo - REVISED 5/30
