Re: Proposed Mask Ordinance

Dear Mayor Bynum and City Council Members:

Respectfully, I would like to request your support in voting in favor of the mask ordinance as proposed by Mayor Bynum. I can say without reservation that requiring masks or facial coverings is <u>mission</u> <u>critical</u> if we are to safely reopen schools this fall. In fact, Union's Board of Education unanimously approved our School Re-Entry Plan for 2020-21 on Monday night, and it requires the wearing of masks at school by all Union teachers, staff, and students.

Our teachers have expressed their concern about their personal safety in the classroom, so the wearing of masks will <u>not</u> be optional at Union. As Tulsa's and our state's growing number of Covid-19 cases continue to escalate, it is important that we take a countywide approach to wearing masks. This minimal measure requires little to no sacrifice in order to prevent further community spread.

Should our community not curtail these alarming numbers, I have grave concerns about schools being able to safely open in August. We must take this disease seriously or it is going to set us back in our attempts to get our students back in school.

That's why I respectfully ask that you approve the mask ordinance being proposed this evening.
