

## Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Funding

The City of Tulsa has been awarded supplemental U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funding through the CARES Act to address community development needs in response to the coronavirus.

Pursuant to the requirements of the CARES Act relating to Homeless Assistance Grants, below is a summary of the projects funded with Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding as of 9/15/2020:
