## Fact Sheet

**WHAT:** PLANiTULSA is a once-in-a-generation, community-wide planning effort that gives residents an opportunity to shape the future of the city through the development of a new Comprehensive Plan.

**WHO:** The PLANiTULSA team, appointed by Mayor Kathy Taylor, includes two citizen committees made up of more than 100 people who will help guide the planning process and get Tulsans involved in the plan's formation. Portland-based Fregonese and Associates, one of the most respected comprehensive planning firms in the country, serves as lead consultant. Funding sources for the plan come from the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County and the Tulsa Community Foundation.

**WHEN:** Launched in May 2008, the planning process will take between 18 months and two years. Hands-on, citywide workshops are set for Sept. 22 and 23 at the Greenwood Cultural Center and BOK Center, respectively. Nine small area workshops will follow in late 2008 and early 2009. Ideas gained from the public workshops will become the foundation of the new Comprehensive Plan.

**WHY:** Tulsa's current Comprehensive Plan is 30 years old and needs to be updated. A new Comprehensive Plan will guide the future physical development of the city, impacting almost every aspect of its residents' lives. Plan policies provide a framework within which individuals, businesses and public officials can make decisions that are consistent with the community's vision and objectives.
