ESTABLISHMENT OF A
PUBLIC WORKS BID COMMITTEE
FOR THE CITY OF TULSA

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tulsa, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. PURPOSE: To establish a Bid Committee to publicly open and read bids received for public works projects for the City of Tulsa.

Section 2. MEMBERSHIP: The Committee will be composed of one member from the Public Works Department, and one member from the Finance Department. A representative from the City Attorney's office will attend each bid opening. The Director of each of these departments will file with the City Clerk the name of their designated representative.

Section 3. DUTIES:


1. To open and publicly read bids received for public works projects for the City of Tulsa.
2. To maintain a record of each bid received recording the bidder, amount of the bid, the project, and date the bid was opened.
3. The Committee will forward the opened bids for each project to the Director of Public Works.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Order shall take effect immediately.
