ESTABLISHMENT OF A CONTRACTORS PREQUALIFICATION  
COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF TULSA

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tulsa, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. PURPOSE. To establish a Contractors Prequalification Committee to perform the duties and exercise the powers conferred upon the Director as defined in Title 11, Chapter 11, Section 1100(B) of the Tulsa Revised Ordinances.

Section 2. MEMBERSHIP. The committee will be composed of five (5) voting members. Four (4) of the members shall be the Director of Public Works, Director of Finance, Director of Parks and Recreation, and the Airport Director. Each shall be members by virtue of their position with the City of Tulsa. Each person holding membership by virtue of their position with the City of Tulsa will name an alternate to attend meetings when they are unable to attend. The alternate will be entitled to vote and exercise the same rights and privileges as the member. A fifth (5th) member shall be appointed by the Mayor. The person appointed by the Mayor shall serve a term of one (1) year or until a successor is appointed and qualified. The original term for the Mayor appointee shall commence on July 1, 1990 and expire June 30, 1991.

Section 3. COMMITTEE POWERS AND DUTIES. The Committee shall exercise the duties assigned to the Director by Title 11, Chapter 11, Section 1101 through 1105 of the Tulsa Revised Ordinances.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Order shall take effect immediately.
