EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 91-08

APPOINTMENT
OF
POLICE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL
AS DEPUTY COURT CLERKS
OF THE
CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Purpose. To comply with Title 23, Section 4, of the Tulsa Revised Ordinances.

Section 2. Appointment. That L. J. Bayles, Jr., J. K. Harris, D. A. Brown, G. B. Poindexter, M. Whitlow, M. Williams, and L. R. Young be and they are hereby appointed as Deputy Court Clerks of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and as such Deputy Court Clerks of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, said appointees shall have the power to:

- A. Administer oaths and affidavits;
- B. Make certificates;
- C. Affix the seal of the Court; and
- D. Generally do and perform all things and acts usual or necessary to be performed by the Clerk of the Court in issuing the process of the Court and in conducting the business of the Court.

Section 3. Effective Date. This order shall take effect immediately.
