
ABOLISHING THE GENERAL SERVICES
DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF TULSA

By virtue of the power vested in me by Article III, Section 1.6 (B), of the Amended Charter of the City of Tulsa, which provides that the Mayor may by Executive Order create or abolish departments of the City, it is hereby ordered:


Section 1. Purpose - To promote the efficient operation of the City of Tulsa. Title 16, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, Sections 100, et seq., creates and provides for the establishment of a General Services Department of the City which is to function under the supervision and control of the Mayor. Its function is to provide administrative, clerical and technical functions and duties previously performed by members of the Police and Fire Departments of the City as designated from time to time by the Mayor. The General Services Department has in fact not existed for many years.

Section 2. General Services Department Abolished. The General Services Department of the City of Tulsa is herewith abolished.


Section 3. Effective Date. This Order shall be effective immediately upon its execution this JAN 15 1998
