EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 95- 01

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING CERTAIN CITY
EMPLOYEES TO ISSUE CODE CITATIONS FOR
VIOLATIONS OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES.

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of
Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby Ordered:

Section 1. PURPOSE: To authorize certain employees of the
Urban Development, Public Works, Airport and Protective Inspections
Departments of the City of Tulsa to issue citations enforcing
certain provisions of the Tulsa Revised Ordinances.

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION: Pursuant to the provisions of Title
29, Chapter 5, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, entitled "Code Citation
and Issuance Authority", the following employees are conferred the
authority to issue citations for the purpose of enforcing
provisions of the Tulsa Revised Ordinances, except for provisions
in Title 27, and those provisions in Title 37, specifically
reserved for enforcement by the Tulsa Police Department:





Section 4. AUTHORITY EXPIRES AUTOMATICALLY ON TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT. The citation authority conveyed herein shall expire automatically upon termination of the code citation officer's employment with the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Order shall be retroactively effective from April 3, 1995, immediately upon its execution.
