AUTHORIZATION FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES  
TO ISSUE CODE CITATIONS FOR  
VIOLATIONS OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL  
ORDINANCES.

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby Ordered:

Section 1. PURPOSE: To authorize certain employees of the City of Tulsa and the Tulsa City-County Health Department to issue citations enforcing certain provisions of the Tulsa Revised Ordinances.

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION: Pursuant to the provisions of Title 29, Chapter 5, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, entitled "Code Citation and Issuance Authority", the following employees are conferred the authority to issue citations for the purpose of enforcing provisions of the Tulsa Revised Ordinances, except for provisions in Title 27, and those provisions in Title 37, specially reserved for enforcement by the Tulsa Police Department:
