EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 93-01

APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE MUNICIPAL  
EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT PLAN BOARD OF TRUSTEES,  
PURSUANT TO TITLE 28, TULSA REVISED  
ORDINANCES, SECTION 1000, AS AMENDED BY  
ORDINANCE NUMBER 17839, EFFECTIVE JANUARY  
1, 1993.

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of  
Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Purpose. To comply with Title 28, Tulsa Revised  
Ordinance, § 1000, as amended by Ordinance Number 17839,  
effective January 1, 1993.

Section 2. Original Appointments. Effective January 1, 1993  
the following members of the Municipal Employees Retirement Plan  
("Plan") Board of Trustees shall be appointed:

A. Sherry L. Reinhardt, as an active, classified Employee  
Participant in the Plan, to serve a term of three (3) years;

B. Preston O. Whitson, as head of the City's Personnel  
Department, to serve a term of three (3) years;

C. Richard McKenzie, as an active, classified Employee  
Participant in the Plan, to term of two (2) years;

D. Ronald L. Payne, as head of the City's Finance  
Department, to serve a term of two (2) years;

E. [Name], as a retired Employee Participant receiving  
income from the Plan, to serve a term of one (1) year;

F. Phillip W. Wood, as City Auditor, an elected City  
official, to serve a term of one (1) year; and

G. Andrew Pierson, as a person who is not a Participant in  
the Plan, an employee or elected City official, to serve an  
indefinite term at the pleasure of the Mayor.

Section 3. Appointment of Successors.

A. Successors to original appointees shall be appointed  
without executive order, in accordance with requirements  
established by Charter. Successors to original appointees serving  
a term of one (1) to three (3) years shall serve a term of three  
(3) years beginning on January 1 and ending at the close of  
December 31.

B. Nominations for appointment of successors to members of the Board of Trustees who are active classified Employee Participants in the Plan shall be made to the Mayor by Contributing Participants of the Plan voting in an election conducted under the supervision of the Administrator for the Plan.

C. All appointments to the Board of Trustees shall be subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the entire membership of the City Council.

Section 4. Effective Date. This order shall take effect immediately.
