EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 92-11
MAY 15, 1992

CONSOLIDATING POLICE DEPARTMENT AND
FIRE DEPARTMENT PUBLIC SAFETY
RESPONSE CENTER AND NINE-ONE-ONE
(911) MANAGEMENT FUNCTIONS AND
APPOINTING DALE S. LeSTOURGEON AS
THE INTERIM OPERATIONS MANAGER OVER
THE PUBLIC SAFETY RESPONSE CENTER.

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. PURPOSE: Pursuant to Article III, Section 1.6 of the 1989 Amended Charter of the City of Tulsa, Public Safety Response Center ("PSRC") and Nine-One-One (911) Emergency Telephone Services management functions performed by the Police Department and the Fire Department shall be and are hereby transferred and consolidated into one (1) Public Safety Communications operation.

Section 2. INTERIM OPERATIONS MANAGER: Effective immediately Telecommunications Manager Dale S. LeSturgeon is appointed as the Interim Operations Manager over Public Safety Communications operations. In this capacity Mr. LeSturgeon shall independently report to the Mayor and/or his designee. The Interim Operations Manager's duties shall include, but are not limited to the following:

A. Supervision, management and administration of the City's Nine-One-One (911) Emergency Telephone Service, as well as non-emergency law enforcement and other telecommunications operations previously performed within Police Department and Fire Department;

B. Supervision, management and administration over all non-sworn personnel previously assigned to the Police Department's Communications Division and the Fire Department's Communications and Information Services Division;

C. Supervision, management and administration over all fixed asset, budgetary, technological, operational and policy making functions within the PSRC or related to public safety communications.

Section 3. COORDINATION: Interim Operations Manager duties shall be coordinated with the advice and cooperation of all sworn and non-sworn personnel of the Fire Department, the Police Department and the Department of Information and Communication Services. The City's Emergency Telephone Service Management Board, Legal and Personnel Departments shall also act in an advisory capacity to facilitate coordinated communications operations.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This order shall take effect on the 15th day of May, 1992.
