EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 92- 15  
AUGUST 21, 1992

AUTHORIZING CERTAIN CITY EMPLOYEES TO ISSUE CITATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENFORCING CERTAIN PENAL PROVISIONS OF THE TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY. Pursuant to Title 27, Section 508(D) of the Tulsa Revised Ordinances, authority to issue citations for the purpose of enforcing certain penal provisions of the Tulsa Revised Ordinances may be conferred on those city employees who are designated and approved by the Mayor.

Section 2. TRAINING COMPLETED. On March 19, 1992, Ronald R. Harvey and William D. Fry attended Code Citation Class conducted by the Personnel Department of the City of Tulsa and therein received three (3) hours of instruction in the necessary procedures involving forms and issuance of citations.

Section 3. APPROVAL AND AUTHORIZATION. The following employees of the City of Tulsa have been recommended by the Building Inspections Manager and are hereby designated as employees authorized to issue citations for the purpose of enforcing the penal provisions of Title 51 and the penal provisions relating to sign violations of Title 42 of the Tulsa Revised Ordinances of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma:

Section 4. AUTHORITY EXPIRES ON TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT. The citation authority conveyed herein shall expire automatically upon termination of the code citation officer's employment with the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.
