DESIGNATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS DEPARTMENT
TO ASSIST HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION AND
IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 5,
TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 1
AND
DESIGNATION OF "COMPLIANCE OFFICIAL"
AND "ADA COMPLIANCE OFFICIAL"

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby ordered as follows.

SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS DEPARTMENT STAFF TO ASSIST HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION. The Human Rights Department ("Department") shall assist the Human Rights Commission ("Commission") in performing the duties and responsibilities assigned to the Commission by the provisions of Title 5, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, Chapter 1 ("Human Rights Ordinance").

SECTION 2. DESIGNATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS DEPARTMENT TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 5, TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 1. The Department shall implement the provisions of the Human Rights Ordinance by:

A. Conducting compliance reviews to determine compliance with the Nondiscriminatory Employee Requirements for Persons who Contract with the City as contained in Title 5, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, Section 110;

B. Conducting such other compliance reviews as are required for the acceptance of grants from the state and federal governments;

C. Receiving or initiating and investigating complaints of discrimination and other acts and practices prohibited by the Human Rights Ordinance; entering into conciliation agreements when appropriate; and referring complaints to the City Prosecutor when appropriate;

D. Receiving, investigating and resolving complaints of discrimination against qualified persons with disabilities; and

E. Performing such other duties and activities as the Mayor may direct from time to time.

SECTION 3. DESIGNATION OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RIGHTS AS COMPLIANCE OFFICIAL. The Director of the Human Rights Department and/or his or her designated representative shall perform the duties assigned to the "Compliance Official" by the provisions of the Human Rights Ordinance and shall further perform such other activities as the Mayor may direct from time to time.

SECTION 4. DESIGNATION OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RIGHTS AS ADA COMPLIANCE OFFICIAL. The Director of the Human Rights Department and/or his or her designated representative shall perform the duties assigned to the "ADA Compliance Official" by the provisions of the Human Rights Ordinance and shall further perform such other activities as the Mayor may direct from time to time.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This order shall take effect on the 5th day of November, 1992.
