APPOINTMENT OF POLICE DEPARTMENT
PERSONNEL AS DEPUTY COURT CLERKS OF
THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA;
CORRECTING A SCRIVENER'S ERROR
CONTAINED IN EXECUTIVE ORDER 92-02.

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. **Purpose.** To comply with Title 23, § 104, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, Title 11, Oklahoma Statutes, § 28-103 and to correct a scrivener's error contained in Executive Order 92-02.

Section 2. **Appointment.** That the attached list of twenty-three (23) employees of the Tulsa Police Department (Exhibit "A") be and hereby are appointed as Deputy Court Clerks of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and as such appointees shall have the power to:

- A. Administer oaths and affidavits;
- B. Make certificates;
- C. Affix the seal of the Court; and
- D. Generally do and perform all things and acts usual or necessary to be performed by the Clerk of the Court in issuing the process of the Court and in conducting the business of the Court.

Section 3. **Effective Date.** This order shall be effective retroactively to and from the date Executive Order 92-02 was effective, January 17, 1992.
