**CLASS TITLE: POOL CASHIER** 

**PURPOSE OF THE CLASSIFICATION:** Under direction is responsible for monitoring pool capacity, collecting entry fees, ensuring accuracy of fees charged, and supporting the Pool Manager and parks staff, and performs other related assigned duties.

- Enforces rules and regulations professionally and courteously
- Represents the City of Tulsa and Tulsa Parks professionally
- Communicates effectively and assists customers with questions and concerns
- Monitors and cleans pool, bath house, and pool fence
- Must report to work on a regular and timely basis
