CLASS TITLE: LIFEGUARD

PURPOSE OF THE CLASSIFICATION: Under direction is responsible for the operation of several outdoor pools, ensuring the safety of patrons, and upholding the City of Tulsa and Tulsa Parks policies and procedures, and performs other related assigned duties.

ESSENTIAL TASKS:

- Works to prevent accidents and eliminate hazards in and around the pool and deck areas to provide an enjoyable experience for the public
- Responds quickly to emergency situations and administers first aid to accident victims, when needed
- Communicates with the public and City staff if additional assistance or equipment is needed
- Monitors pool zones in assigned areas for infractions or safety concerns
- Enforces rule and regulations courteously but firmly
- Inspects the pool and pool grounds daily for any safety issues or repairs needed to ensure the health and safety of patrons
- Educates patrons and informs them of the purpose and need for rules and regulations
- Monitors and cleans the pool, bath house and pool fence
- May be required to temporarily guard other pools
- Focuses on creating, developing, and maintaining a sense of teamwork among lifeguards
- Must report to work on a regular and timely basis

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential tasks.

QUALIFICATIONS:

<u>Training and Experience</u>: Completion of 10th Grade. Possession of a current CPR, First Aid, AED and Life Guarding Certificates required. Swim instructors must possess current CPR, First Aid, AED and Water Safety Instructing certificates. Successful completion of the City of Tulsa Parks Department Water Test required.

Knowledge, Abilities and Skills: Ability to recognize and respond to emergencies through knowledge and application of lifeguard surveillance and rescue techniques; ability to enforce pool policies while providing a high level of customer service to patrons; ability to display a positive attitude for all patrons and staff; ability to assess a situation and make an informed decision; ability to work as a team with other lifeguards, staff and management; ability to positively promote the City of Tulsa and Tulsa Parks to peers and patrons; ability to follow directions quickly; ability to respond quickly and use good judgement; ability to communicate effectively with diverse communities to achieve the goals of Tulsa Parks.

<u>Physical Requirements:</u> Physical requirements include arm and finger dexterity enough to use a keyboard and telephone; occasional carrying and pushing up to 50 pounds; may be subject to walking, standing, sitting, running, reaching, balancing, bending, handling and climbing; and vision, speech and hearing sufficient to perform the essential tasks.

<u>Licenses and Certificates:</u> Possession of a current CPR, First Aid, AED and Life Guarding Certificates required. Swim instructors must possess current CPR, First Aid, AED and Water Safety Instructing certificates. Successful completion of the City of Tulsa Parks Department Water Test required.

WORKING ENVIRONMENT: Working environment is primarily outdoors and in high humidity. May be exposed to pool chemicals, bodily fluids, heat, and slippery surfaces.
