- ▶ Improve Our Tulsa is the City's primary source of City facilities, equipment, and street infrastructure funding.
- ▶ It is the combination of Third Penny Sales Tax and GO Bond programs.
- ▶ It is an extension of the 2019 Improve Our Tulsa package
- ▶ Approving will not raise taxes
- ▶ It includes funding to help with critical housing needs across Tulsa
