



A comprehensive City initiative to better highlight the cumulative work being done to address homelessness at the intersection of housing and mental health.

Path to Home is a three-part initiative that helps highlight and identify the work already being done in this space, the work that is in the planning and development phases, and the reporting mechanisms for Tulsans to help their community and those in need.

As part of the work being done, the Mayor/Council Housing, Homelessness, and Mental Health (3H) Task Force has released its Path to Home Recommendations, which include four goals and 33 actions to address community needs.

GOALS AND ACTIONS INCLUDE:

- 1. Housing Production & Preservation**
Twelve actions to help increase housing choice and housing affordability across all income levels.
- 2. Outreach & Early Intervention**
Nine actions to provide immediate programming and proactive assistance for those experiencing homelessness.
- 3. Leverage & Align Funding**
Four actions to assist the City to adequately fund and prioritize resources needed to help address community needs.
- 4. Community Standards & Resources**
Eight actions to enhance community standards and coordination efforts between City of Tulsa departments and service providers.
