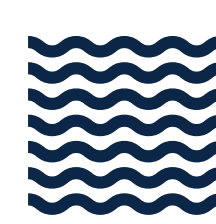
RULES & REGULATIONS

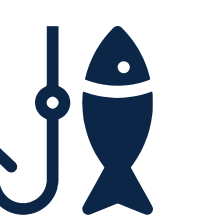

LAKE RULES



- **No lifeguards on duty:** Use at your own risk.
- No swimming or wading.
- Adult supervision recommended.
- Personal Floatation Devices (PFD) recommended.
- No wakes.
- No use of combustion engines on watercraft.
PERMITS AVAILABLE IN CERTAIN CASES
- No alcohol.
UNLESS OTHERWISE PERMITTED
- No blocking boat ramp or leaving vehicle unattended on boat ramp.
- Dogs allowed on watercrafts, but not in the water. City leash law applies everywhere but on watercraft.
- Please access Zink Lake from one of four identified entry locations.
- No access to locations of Zink Lake where buoys or signage prohibit such access.
- If conditions warrant the closure of Zink Lake, notice will be posted on River Parks Authority media channels and at the four (4) Zink Lake access points.
- Oklahoma Boating Safety Regulation Act applies to watercraft.
- No campfires.
- All other River Parks Authority rules apply.

FISHING RULES



- Adult supervision recommended.
- Oklahoma fishing regulations and permitting apply.
- No bow fishing or fishing by set (bank) lines, trotlines, float (jug) lines, gigs, or spears.
- No fishing in or from any part of the flume (Tulsa Wave Park) structure.
- No fishing from the Williams Crossing Pedestrian Bridge.
- No fishing from any part of the Zink Lake dam structure.
- No fishing from any areas marked as no fishing.

TULSA WAVE PARK RULES



- **No lifeguards on duty:** Use at your own risk.
- No swimming or wading.
- Adult supervision recommended.
- Personal Floatation Devices (PFD) recommended.
- Whitewater-specific vessels recommended.
- Protective headwear recommended.
- Secure footwear is recommended.
- No leashes or ropes on watercrafts.
- Dogs prohibited in the flume, leash laws apply outside of the flume.
