

EMERGENCY DISASTER PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2026, the National Weather Service issued a Winter Storm Warning, with up to 18 inches of snowfall imminent, localized loss of power, and life-threatening wind-chill values as low as -20 degrees; and

WHEREAS, immediate attention is required to protect public health, reduce damage, insure public safety and render emergency relief; and

WHEREAS, I, Monroe Nichols IV, Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, do find that the aforementioned conditions constitute a threat to the safety and welfare of the city, and create an emergency disaster situation within the meaning of Section 683.3, Oklahoma Emergency Act of 2003, as amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Monroe Nichols IV, Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, acting under the power vested in me under Tulsa's Revised Charter do hereby declare the city of Tulsa to be a disaster area, entitled to aid, relief and assistance and do hereby direct the implementation of the City-County Emergency Operations Plan.


