Event Description: Team Soundpony, presented by Triad Bank, is proud to host the fifth annual Audacity: Osage County on Saturday, August 1, 2026. Audacity: Osage County is a night gravel bicycle race held in Osage County, with start and finish at The Soundpony Bar in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Now in its fifth year, Audacity has become a beloved community cycling event that draws participants from across the region. The event offers two route distances — a 69-mile and a 44-mile variant — both conducted on gravel roads through Tulsa and Osage County. As a night race, the event begins in the evening hours and participants carry their own lighting equipment in accordance with safe cycling practices.

The Soundpony Bar serves as the event hub, hosting participant registration, pre-race staging, and the post-race finish celebration. The event fosters community engagement, promotes cycling in the region, and celebrates the natural beauty of Osage County's rural roads.

Team Soundpony is committed to leaving all event areas clean and free of litter following the conclusion of Audacity: Osage County. The following plan outlines our approach to waste collection and disposal.

Volunteer Cleanup Crew

Designated event volunteers will be responsible for post-event cleanup at the start/finish venue (The Soundpony Bar) and the immediate surrounding area. Volunteers will be briefed on cleanup responsibilities prior to the event.

Supplies

Large heavy-duty garbage bags will be provided to all cleanup volunteers. Volunteers will collect all event-related waste including cups, packaging, signage materials, and any other debris generated by the event.

Disposal

All collected waste will be consolidated and disposed of in the existing dumpsters located on the premises of The Soundpony Bar. No waste will be left on public property, roadsides, or neighboring properties.

Route Responsibility

As a self-supported gravel race conducted on rural roads, participants are expected to carry out any waste generated along the route (such as food wrappers and hydration packaging) and dispose of it responsibly upon returning to the finish area.

Post-Event Inspection

Following cleanup, an event organizer will conduct a walkthrough of the venue area to confirm the space has been returned to its original condition.

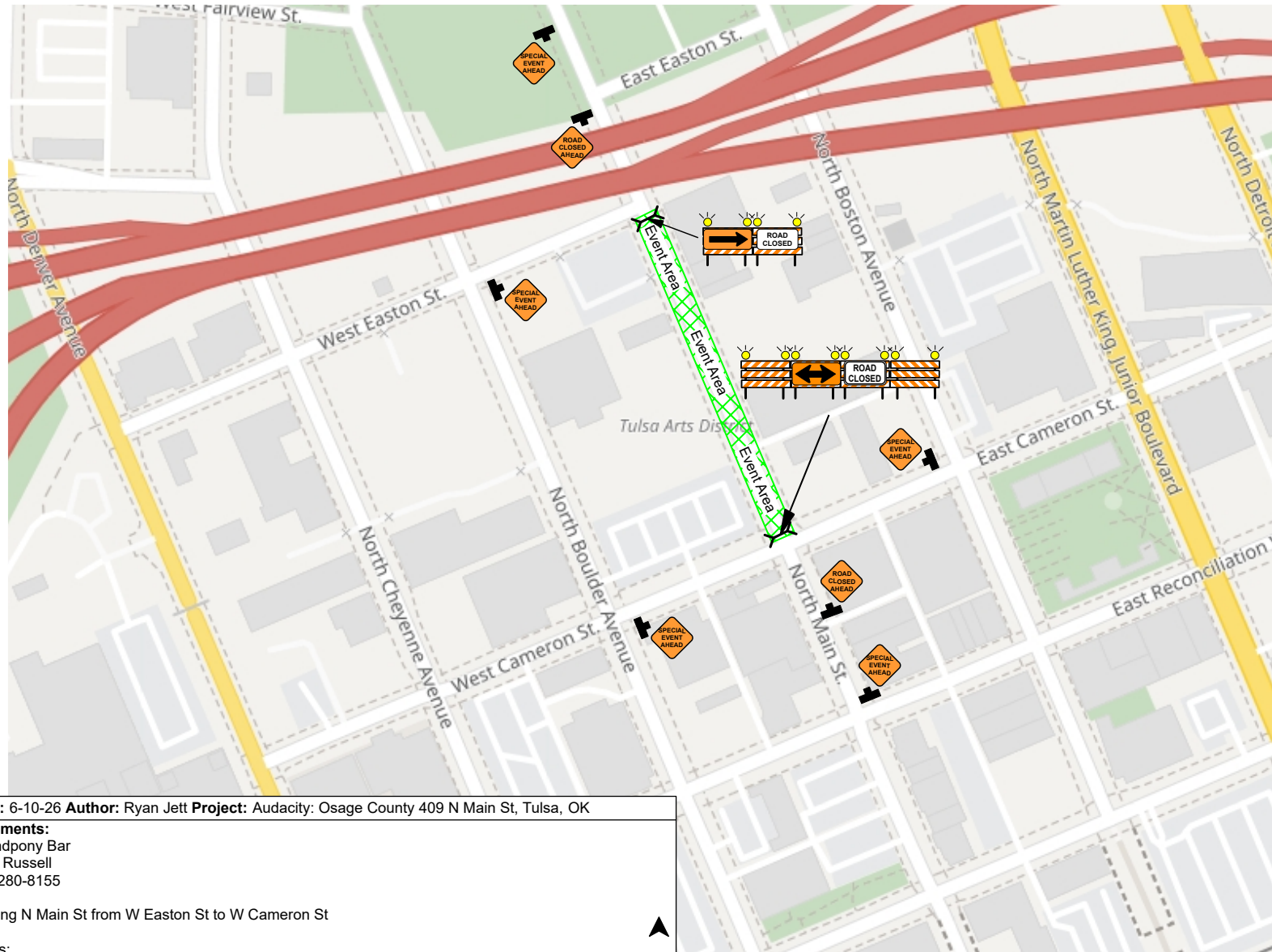

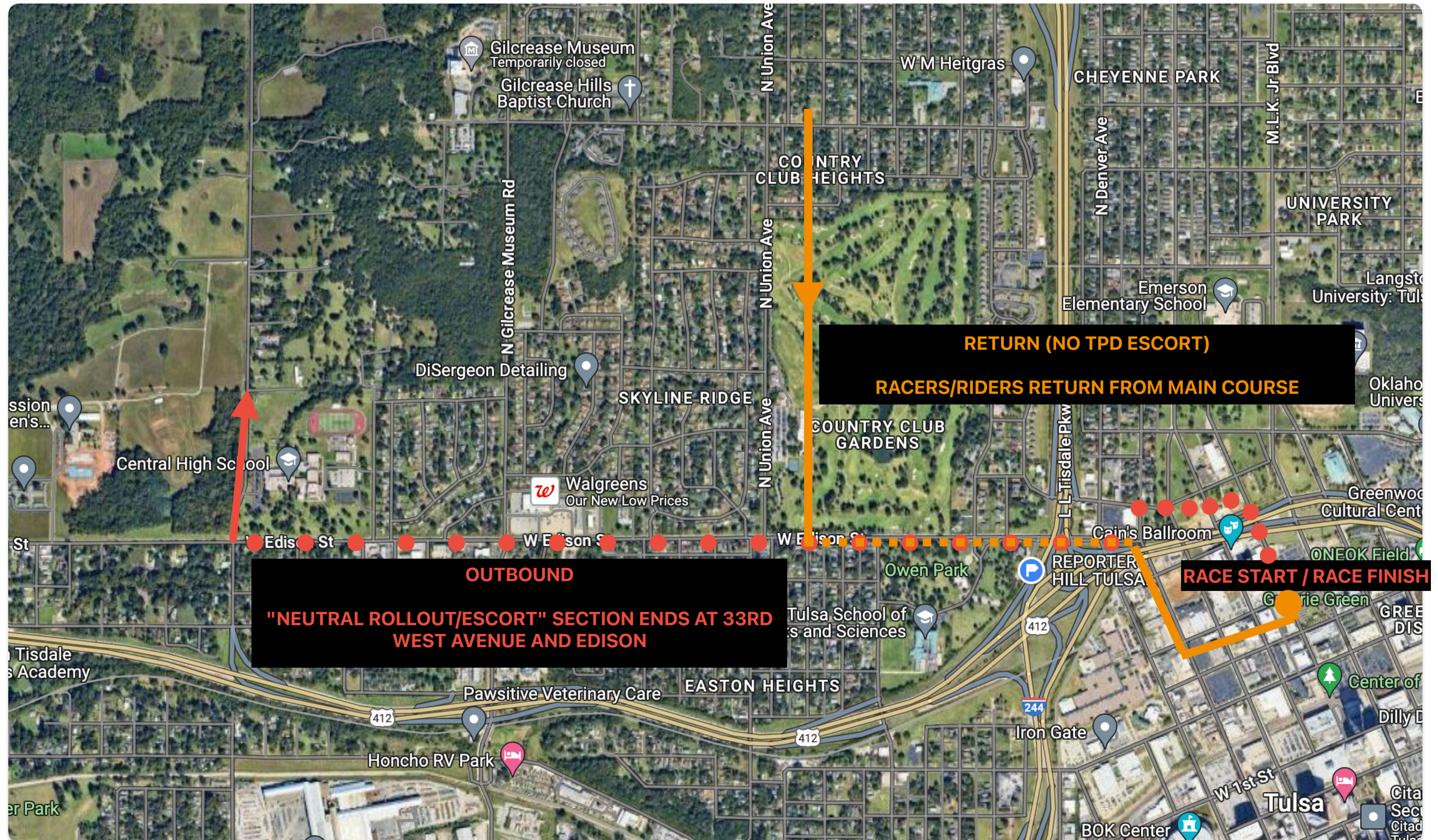
