A door-to-door shared-ride transportation service designed for individuals who cannot independently use the MetroLink fixed-route bus system. (ADA Eligible)

AERO

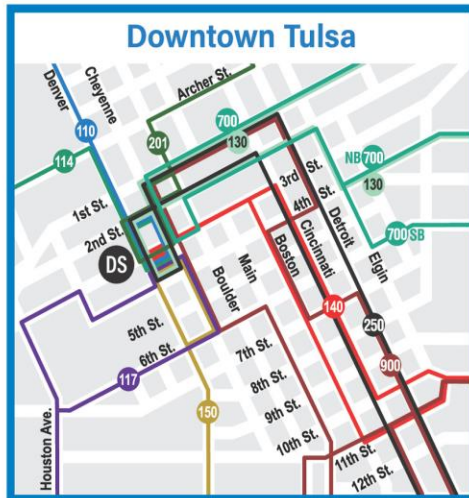
PEORIA BRT

- 600K+ Trips Last Year
 - +50% increase from the prior route
- Route 66 BRT – COMING LATE 2028.
 - Funding via federal grants
- Serves 1 in 4 jobs and 1 in 5 residents in Tulsa, within ¼ mile walk
