Tulsa International Mayfest

Summary of Requested Street Closings for Mayfest 2017

Off-duty Tulsa Police Officers will be stationed at all major intersections during the festival, as well as the day of setup prior to the festival, to assist with the vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Barricades, as required, will be utilized at 3rd & Cincinnati, 3rd & Boulder, 4th & Boston, 4th & Boulder, 5th & Boston, 5th & Boulder, 6th & Boulder, as well as on Main from 3rd to 7th.

An officer will be stationed at the barricades on 3rd Street between Boston and Cincinnati, throughout the event for the express purpose of:

- 1. Ensuring PAC turn-around traffic's access to the PAC.
- 2. Ensuring no vehicles other than PAC patrons park in front of the PAC.

Tuesday, May 16th City to bag meters (at 5:00 p.m.) until festival Closing on **Sunday, May 21st** (at 8:00pm)

Parking meters are requested to be "bagged"

- 3rd Street, Boulder to Cincinnati, both sides of street
- Boston, 3rd to 4th, both sides of the street

- Main from 3rd to 7th, both sides of street.
