**Fines:** Set court date 10 working days from the date of violation. The court division is determined by the last number of the citation (see below). List time as 8:30 a.m.

**BOOK TO COURT:** Set court date 10-20 working days from the date of the violation. Court division is determined by the last number of the citation:

- 1-3 Division I
- 4-6 Division II
- 7-0 Division III

When issuing multiple citations to a defendant, if one citation is required to be booked to court, please book all citations to court. **DO NOT** place pre-set monetary fines on those citations. They should read CRT or COURT. Use the lowest number to determine division. Do not split divisions on citations issued to same defendant.

**JUVENILE TRAFFIC:** State law requires parental notification when a citation with a pre-set fine is issued to a juvenile. Fill out the back of the green copy and attach it to the hard copy. When a juvenile citation requires a court appearance, the Court Division is *Night Court* at 4:00 p.m. on the first Wednesday that is 10-20 working days from the date of the violation. Juveniles must appear in court with a parent or legal guardian. Do not set any Juvenile traffic on Wednesdays that are legal holidays (check your court calendar).

**JUVENILE CRIMINAL:** Place *JBDC* in the fine box and *When Notified* for the court date. A parent or legal guardian must accompany juveniles appearing in court.

**JUVENILE CURFEW/PARK CURFEW OR JUVENILE IN POSSESSION OF TOBACCO PRODUCT:** Place *JDMC* in the fine box. Court date is the first Wednesday after ten working days at 4:00 p.m. (check your court calendar).
