## **CLASS TITLE: UTILITIES TESTING ANALYST**

**PURPOSE OF THE CLASSIFICATION:** Under general supervision performs advanced level systems testing and analysis to ensure accurate revenue billing in the City's Utilities Services section and other related assigned duties.

## **ESSENTIAL TASKS:**

- Coordinates and executes comprehensive testing
- · Designs and writes specifications, develops and drafts test plans and analyzes and reports results
- Reviews documentation of new software releases, identifies problems and potential enhancements
- Performs back up duties to include reconciling the utility billing system and producing financial reports, returned checks and write-offs
- Executes daily batch setup
- Reviews the administration of the bankruptcy process
- Coordinates projects to ensure proper procedures followed and compliance with relevant laws
- Acts as team leader on assigned departmental projects
- Attends weekly system team, staff and other meetings as required
- Supports the Credit and Collections section with write-off administration
- Creates reports to identify errors and improve efficiencies
- Must report to work on a regular and timely basis

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential tasks.

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

<u>Training and Experience</u>: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in accounting, business administration or other related field, including SQL computer classes or related report writing language; and three (3) years of utility systems experience.

Knowledge, Abilities and Skills: Considerable knowledge of the principles, practices and methods of accounting; considerable knowledge of system testing; considerable knowledge of laws, ordinances, regulations and policies governing utilizes; good working knowledge of systems procedures and practices; and considerable knowledge of the use of database and spreadsheet software. Ability to analyze and interpret billing records and to prepare accurate and complete reports; ability to develop testing programs for utilities' systems, perform tests, analyze results and recommend solutions; and the ability to understand and influence the behavior of others within the organization, customers or the public in order to achieve job objectives and cause action or understanding.

<u>Physical Requirements:</u> Physical requirements include arm and hand steadiness and finger dexterity enough to use a keyboard and telephone; lifting and carrying up to five pounds; may be subject to sitting for extended periods of time, standing, walking, bending and reaching; and vision, speech and hearing sufficient to perform the essential tasks.

Licenses and Certificates: Possession of a valid Oklahoma Class "D" Operator's license.

**WORKING ENVIRONMENT:** Working environment is primarily indoors in an office setting; and occasionally will require travel to customer locations to inspect service setup outdoors and be in close proximity to open meter pits.
