<u>Knowledge</u>, <u>Abilities and Skills</u>: Good knowledge of janitorial services. Ability to write legibly; ability to follow verbal and written instructions; and the ability to understand and influence the behavior of others within the organization, customers, or the public in order to achieve job objectives and cause action or understanding.

<u>Physical Requirements:</u> Physical requirements include arm and hand steadiness and finger dexterity enough to use a two-way radio and telephone; occasional lifting, carrying, and pulling up to 5 pounds; may be subject to walking, standing, reaching, balancing, bending, kneeling, handling, feeling, smelling, and twisting; and vision, speech, and hearing sufficient to perform the essential tasks.

Licenses and Certificates: Possession of a valid Oklahoma Class "D" Operator's License.

WORKING ENVIRONMENT: Working environment is primarily indoors and occasionally outdoors.
