THE TENT MUST ALSO BE TAKEN DOWN WHEN A HURRICANE IS FORECAST WITHIN 12 HOURS. TENT MAY BE ERECTED WHEN STORM PASSES THE AREA.
- 4. USING ANSI/ASCE STANDARDS 7-05 THE TENT IS DESIGNED FOR 90MPH WIND IN A CLASS "C" OPEN TERRAIN LOCATION WITH A 3 YEAR RETURN PERIOD DUE TO THE TEMPORARY NATURE OF IT'S LOCATION. THE RESULTING PRESSURE LOAD "P" ON THE SURFACE OF THE TENT IS 16.2 PSF, ON THE TENT SURFACE AND IN ADDITION TO THE APPLIED LOAD A PRE-STRESS LOAD ON THE MEMBRANE HAS BEEN INCLUDED.
- 5. THE \$\frac{5}{8}" DIA. STORM GUYS ONLY NEED TO BE INSTALLED FOR TIMES WHEN WINDS OF 60 MPH OR MORE ARE FORECAST OR AS REQUIRED BY LOCAL BUILDING OFFICIALS WHEN UNFORECASTED STORMS OF 60MPH WINDS OR GREATER ARE COMMON TO THE AREA. STORM GUYS SHALL BE SECURED TO TRACTOR TRAILER TRUCKS. KEYS FOR TRUCKS MUST BE PUT IN THE CIRCUS OFFICE.



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

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




Main Tent Roof Plan





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

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





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
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
Main Tent Elevation



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

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
